Mama's Kitchen

Chicken Zinfandel w/Gravy (serves 6)

This is an easy and delicious recipe - One of my favorites to prepare for special dinner guest. I call it Chicken Zinfandel because that's the wine I had on hand the first time I made it. You may call it Chicken Chardonnay or Chicken Pinot - as long as it is always a white wine!

Ingredients:
3 chicken breasts
Milk
Swiss Cheese - sliced thin
Italian bread crumbs for dredging
Tabasco sauce
Italian seasoning / Herb Provence
Salt and pepper
Fresh Grated Parmesan Cheese
Can of Cream of Chicken soup (I

Can of Cream of Chicken soup (I prefer Organic Pacific - you can find it at Publix)

White wine (Chardonay, Pinot, or Zinfandel)

Preheat oven 375 degrees. Slice chicken breast in half to make six pieces - tenderize gently with meat mallet or vigorously to get your frustrations out. Place chicken in bowl and cover with milk. Add tabasco until milk is pink - it won't make it spicy hot just tasty; set aside ... at least 20 minutes.

In a separate bowl, combine 1 cup of Italian bread crumbs, 1/4 cup fresh grated parmesan cheese, Italian seasoning, salt and pepper.

Take chicken breast out of milk and dredge in Italian bread crumb mix. Lay 1-2 slices of swiss cheese on top and gently roll chicken up & place on a greased pan. (I use butter, coconut oil or Olive oil) Repeat for all chicken breast pieces. I try to not let them touch - sprinkle a little extra bread crumbs on the top of the chicken to make sure they're covered.

Cook for 30 minutes or until done to your liking.

While that's in the oven prepare the gravy. Take a sauce pan, combine 1 can of cream of chicken soup and use that same can to measure 1 can of wine. Mix together. Season with salt/pepper and a shake of Italian seasonings. Cook on low for 10 -15 minutes.

I serve the gravy in a gravy dish or bowl - so guest can pour over their chicken. This is great served w/mashed potatoes, roasted carrots and English peas.




