Math

- ▶ Where are the key word(s) in the story / word problem?
- ▶ What words or phrases from the problem led you to that conclusion?
- ▶ What evidence from the problem supports that your answer is reasonable?

- ▶ How did you know which operation to use?

Science

- ▶ What do you observe?
- ▶ How do the effects of your experiment support/refute your hypothesis?
- ▶ What in your research brought you to your hypothesis?

Cite evidence

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- ▶ What evidence from the text leads you to your questions?

Social Studies

- ▶ Where in history have you seen this before?
- ▶ How does the map, artifact, timeline, etc. support your answer?
- ▶ Where have you seen people behave like this before?

Social Studies

- ▶ What in her/his actions supports your conclusion?

Cite evidence

Music

- ▶ What do you hear that tells you the mood of the song/section?
- ▶ How is the song like others by the same composer?
- ▶ What evidence tells you the tone of this piece?

Cite evidence

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- ▶ What about this piece reminds you of another piece?

Art

- ▶ What do you notice is the same across all of this artist's work?
- ▶ In what period do you think this was created? Why?
- ▶ How did the artist use perspective / color / shading, media, etc. use capture the subject?

Cite evidence

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- ▶ What about this piece reminds you of another piece?

- ▶ What makes this a team sport / individual sport?
- ▶ What muscles are being worked in this movement? How do you know?
- ▶ How do you know this is an aerobic / anaerobic exercise?
