Hanukkah



Start with "Dreidel" and go to "Candles"

Teachers/Parents: Give students clues for each new word; or simply tell them the new word and talk about it after the student makes it.

Dreidel → **CLUE:** A top played with by Jewish children on Hanukkah. Take away 4 letters to make a color.

Red → **CLUE:** Change 1 letter to make what you sleep on.

Bed → **CLUE:** To force something into a curved shape. Add 1 letter.

Bend → **CLUE:** What you do with a letter that you write to a friend. Change 1 letter.

Send → **CLUE:** The grainy substance found on a beach or seashore. Change 1 letter.

Sand → **CLUE:** Your fingers are attached to this. Change 1 letter.

Hand → **CLUE:** To be good or skilled at doing something. Add 1 letter to the end.

Handy → **CLUE:** A sweet treat. Change 1 letter.

Candy → **CLUE:** There are 9 of these on the Menorah during Hanukkah. Replace the last letter with 3 letters.
