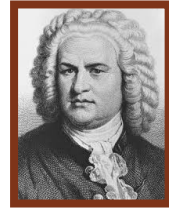

This is also a fundraiser for LADS and volunteers are needed to help support the event & (for those with a desire to be in the spotlight) to be performers in the event.

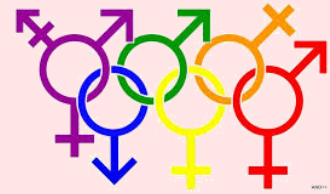

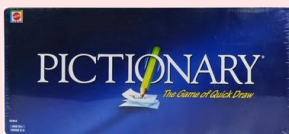

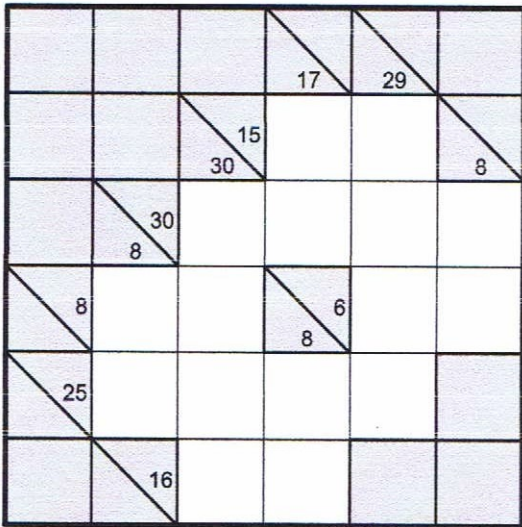

How to solve Kakuro

Kakuro puzzles are like a combination of a crossword & a Sudoku puzzle. (They are also known as "Cross Sums") The goal is to fill all empty squares using numbers 1-9 so the sum of each horizontal block equals the clue on it's left, and the sum of each vertical block equals it's sum on it's top. In addition, no number can be used in the same block more than once.

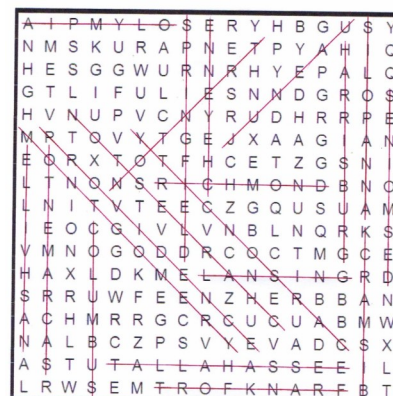

May 6, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 1:05 PM.

From the President

Recognition of lifetime members present, Dan Bartle, Phyllis Ross, and Dan Brown

Recognition of guests present: Jason from Stealing Hearts Rescue, Chuck from Mulligans Manor and Aaron From OZ Bar.

Birthday Celebrations: Brian, Jerry, Angel & Myron

Charities for 2017/2018: There were 3 charities up for vote. Halo, Mulligans Manor and Stealing Hearts Rescue. Chuck from Mulligans Manor spoke about their organization and what they do. Jason from Stealing Hearts Rescue spoke about their organization and what they do. Halo was unable to send a representative due to conflicting schedule and several people out ill. Voting slips were passed out to eligible members of LADS to vote on 2 charities for 2017/2018. Votes were tallied and Mulligans Manor was one winner and there was a tie with Halo and Stealing Hearts Rescue. Because of the tie, the President was asked to vote on the tie breaker. Jeff voted for Stealing Hearts Rescue as the other winner.

Aaron from OZ Bar: spoke about his participation in the 'Sexiest Bartender' event held in the community. He also spoke about his involvement in the group 'American Veterans for Equal Rights'. This group supports a charity every year and he is going to propose to them LADS. Jeff mentioned that last year LADS donated Bingo charity funds for the month of May to the 'Sexiest Bartender' event. There was a motion on the floor for May Bingo charity funds go to Aaron and it was seconded. A vote was taken and LADS approved for May Bingo charity funds to Aaron for the 'Sexiest Bartender' event.

Campout Games: Jeff mentioned that a suggestion was made that LADS officially name the campout games, AKA 'Sissy Olympics' after Willie G. For many years, Willie was the chair person who hosted the campout games. There was a suggestion that the games be named 'Willie Games'. A motion was made to name the campout games 'Willie Games' and the motion was seconded. The club voted and approved that the campout games will now be named 'Willie Games'.

Partnership with OZ: Jeff asked the club if they would like to have a display board up on the wall at OZ. Jeff spoke to Mike (OZ Bar manager) who said was very receptive to the idea of LADS having a display board up on the wall at OZ. The board would display information about LADS, posters of future events, pictures, etc. A motion was made and seconded, and the club approved the display board. A search will be made for the display board.

Jello Shots for June 2017: OZ bartenders will sell jello shots for the month of June. All proceeds will be donated to LADS. OZ is providing everything at no cost to LADS.

San Diego Obligation to Dan Bartle: \$283.00 is still owed to Dan Bartle. With the various fundraisers coming up in the near future, this will be paid back.

Calendar: Jeff mentioned that a suggestion was made that LADS make a calendar for 2018. The calendar could include recipes, photos, LADS events, etc. Jeff opened it up for discussion. Mike (OZ Bar manager) mentioned that he has printer connections and could check on costs. Dan Brown and Dan Bartel have connections to binding. Quinten mentioned that maybe we could sell ads for each month. Also, include some old pictures of LADS. Jeff asked if anyone would like to chair this effort and did not get any volunteers. Jeff said that he would talk to Doug who suggested the idea.

From the Vice President:

Past Events: Poker run total was \$142.00. Volunteers were thanked and Jim mentioned that Thank You cards were mailed to all participating bars.

Chili Cook-off/Salsa Tasting: Will be held after the meeting today at 2pm. A donation of \$5.00 will get you an entry into the event.

Kentucky Derby: \$5.00 entry and all money goes back to winners of Win, Place & Show. Last year there were 3 pools. Post time is 3:34pm.

June 3rd meeting and 'Pride Day': there will be decorations, contest for 'best dressed', after meeting game of 'What's In Your Pocket'. Brian asked for other game ideas. There will be a group photo.

June 23rd OZ Poker Tournament: OZ is hosting this event as a fund raiser for LADS. The winner will receive \$100.00. OZ will provide the poster. LADS will need to provide 3 volunteers to sell jello shots and 50/50 tickets.

July 1st meeting – Red/White/Blue – Pottluck: LADS will provide the hotdogs and sloppy joes. Members and OZ patrons will bring a side dish. There will be a sign-up sheet at the next meeting.

July 8th – OZ Turn=About Show: this is a fund raiser for LADS. Aaron from OZ will be the host. Anyone wanting to participate in the show will need to see Aaron.

Bingo: Brian asked for volunteer for bingo callers.

From the Treasurer:
