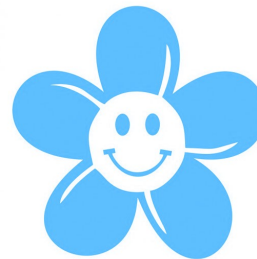
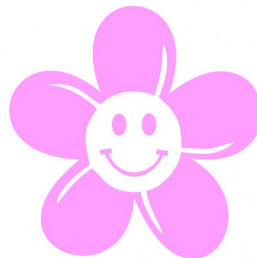
LADS General Meeting
