- 1. The animal that lives in Kosovo has 175 surviving individuals.
- 2. The species that lives in Jamaica was listed 1 year before the animal with a population size of 490.
- 3. Of the animal added to the list in 1999 and the animal with a population size of 420, one lives in Kosovo & the other is the osbele oryx.
- 4. Neither the byengo bat or the lisner cat is the species added to the list in 2009.
- 5. The animal that lives in Slovakia is either the species with a population size of 455 or the animal with a population size of 175.
- 6. The dobra dingo doesn't live in Valenzuela.
- 7. The lisner cat was listed 1 year after the byengo bat.
- 8. Of the osbele oryx and the animal that lives in Valenzuela, one was recognized as endangered in 2010 and the other was recognized as endangered in 2006.


