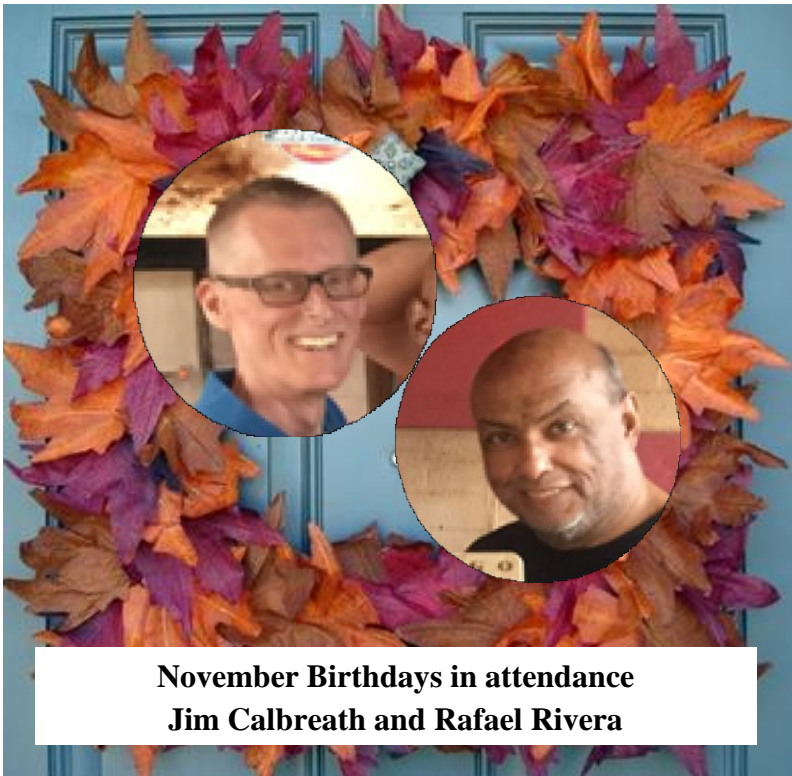
Mike Dailey Awarded 2017 LADS Humanitarian Award in Memory of Char

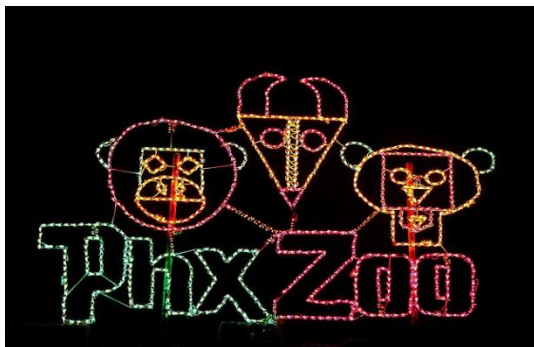
