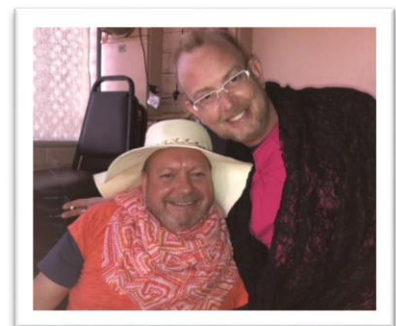
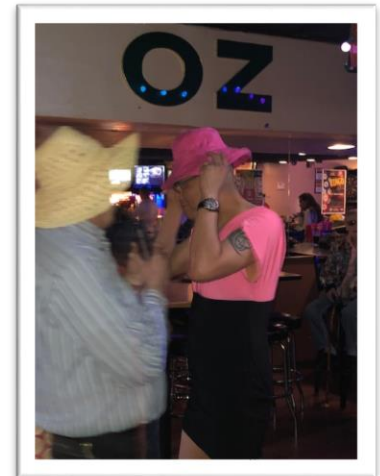

Danny Klevin Poker Run

The annual Danny Klevin Poker Run will be played on April 21, 2018. Oz Bar will be the host bar. The object of the game is to register at one of the participating bars, pay the \$15 entry fee and receive a Poker Run passport. The participating bars are Bar1, Bunkhouse, Cruisin' 7th, Diablos, Oz (Host bar) and The Rock. Once you have the passport, you go to each of the participating bars, purchase a beverage and receive a raffle ticket and a sealed card. You compile all the raffle tickets and sealed cards and proceed to the Check In station at Oz Bar. At the Check In station, your sealed cards will be opened to determine your poker hand. LADS will announce the raffle winners and the top 6 card hands. The raffle prizes are prizes donated by each of the participating bars. The cash prizes for the top 6 winning poker hands will be based on the number of participants. 50 percent of the money taken in will go to LADS and the other 50 percent will be for prizes. The prize distribution is as follows:

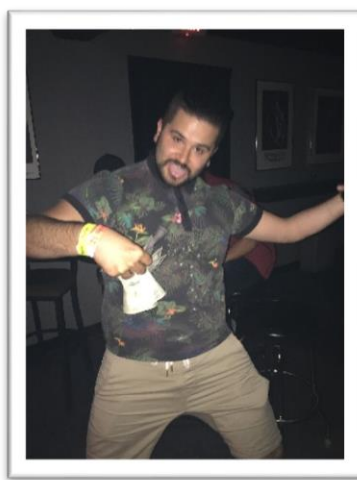
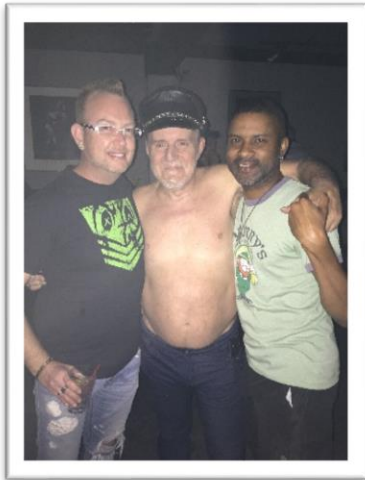
