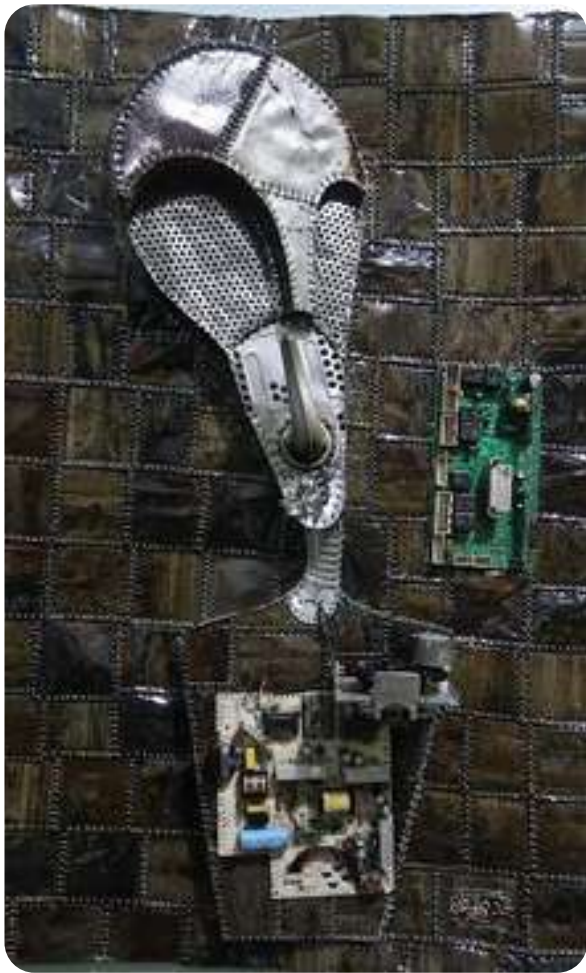

His main inspiration has always been hope for better tomorrow. He uses acrylic paint as a medium to portray his subjects in a realistic manner while using color according to the mood he wants to support the story of his subjects .

Born in 1997 in Asembo, Kenya ,Clinton moved with his parents to Kibera slums in Nairobi to look for greener pastures ,he joined Kibera primary school and later started painting while in class seven in order to pay for his school fees.

He has been featured in several group exhibitions ;Hamptons fine art fair, Nycartwalk, Kenya art dairy 2019, The international school of kenya FOTA art show and the affordable show by the Nairobi National Museum of Kenya .

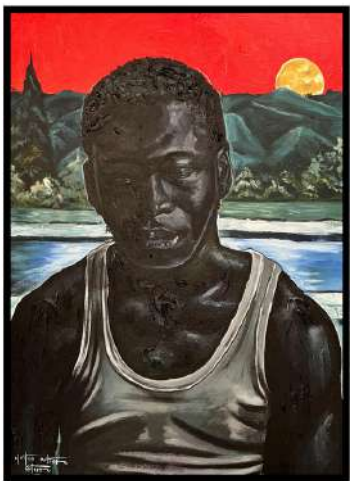

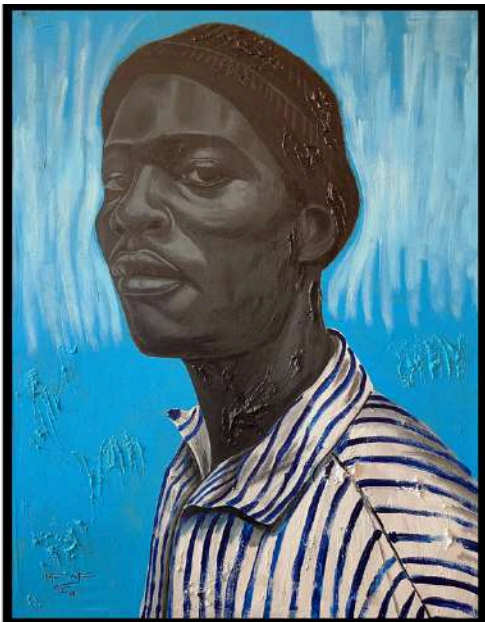

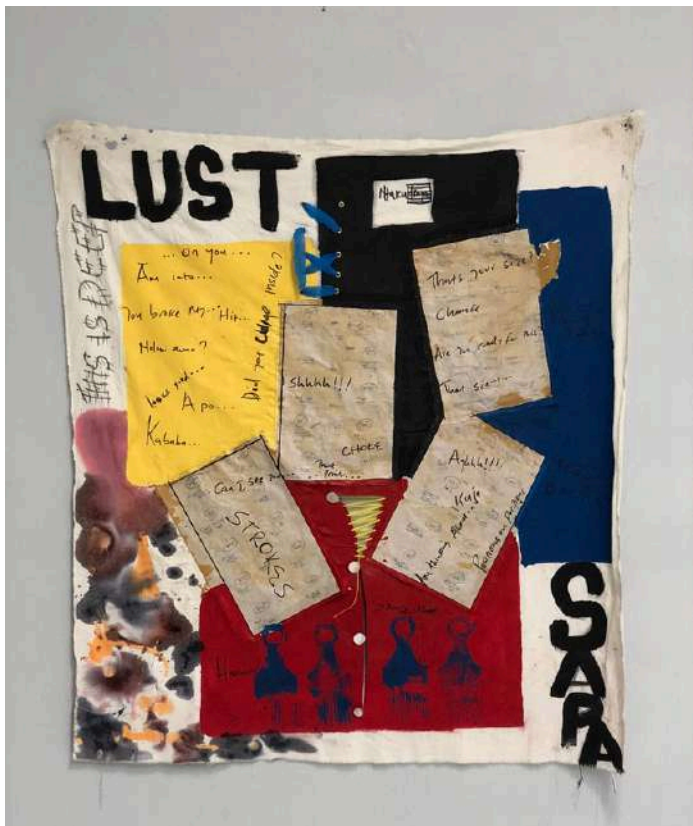

His passion for art began in his childhood, encouraged by his older brother.

“I come from a humble background. My parents knew we had talents but did not believe in art until I sold my first painting and paid for my school.

Art for me is something I believe I was born to do, it's my purpose.”

Chesta has been inspired by artists like Eloy Morales, Marco Grassi and Kelvin Okafor among others.

In his sincere and eloquently expressive pop realism, African tradition meets contemporary imagery, creating critical and political perspectives.

His imaginative and distinctive pop-realistic idiom is based on a bold blending of tones using different sizes of brushes that he called STROKE FACE.

OTIENO GOMBA



The artist Otieno Gomba was born in 1974, and bred in Nairobi Kenya.

In 2001 he and fellow artist Otieno Kota founded the pioneering Maasai Mbili Art Centre – which serves as a studio cum gallery and a platform for many creatives from the area.

Since then Gomba has developed his own distinctive style, referred to as ‘ghetto art’, and while painting is at the heart of his practice Gomba also ventures into community outreach projects, conceptual art, fashion, mixed media and music. His work has been exhibited widely both nationally and internally.
