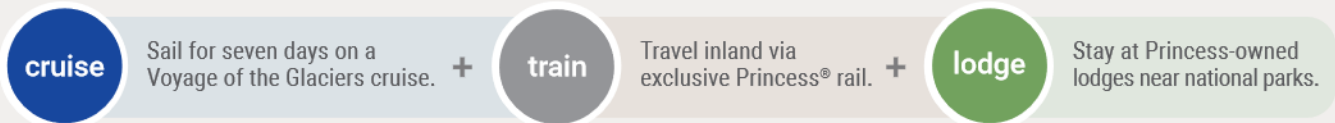

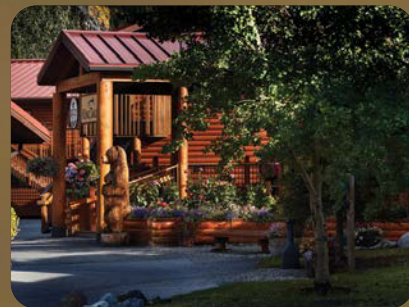


Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge®
