CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Hollingsworth gave the call to order and Pledge of Allegiance.

INVOCATION:

Councilwoman Dickerson gave the invocation to council.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the county’s plans for Setzler Alley, Market Street, and Glenn Street.

MAYOR PRESENTS:

Mayor Hollingsworth had a drawing of the plans for these streets for council to look at. He said Market Street to Glenn Street is a state road. They want the town to take ownership of Setzler

Alley. He said if we do this it would save money on the grant. He said they need to know so DOT can start working with the engineers and we can get an ordinance done and maybe hold a public hearing on this matter.

Councilman Worthy asked if that meant we would have to pave that road.

Councilman Hill asked is this going to cost the town any money. Mayor Hollingsworth answered no.

He asked how does everyone feel about taking ownership of the street? Councilman Thomas and Councilwoman Dickerson are in favor.

Motion to accept ownership of Setzler Alley made by Councilman Thomas and seconded by Councilwoman Dickerson. Our vote doesn't make it official unless DOT agrees. Councilman Lane asked what the green spaces were. All in favor. This is not official until we pass an ordinance.
