1 Introduction

In this Privacy Policy:

'Us', we, 'our' or 'ours' means Mooncat Books Ltd.

'You' and 'your', means you, the person visiting the website or registering to be

included on our mailing list.

If in using our website, you provide us with personal information, we will process that

information in accordance with current legislation and it will only be retained for as

long as necessary to provide you with our services.

We collect data for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy and will directly ask for

your consent to collect and process your data, as set out below. To the extent that

further data is required, we will always seek your consent.

Where processing personal data is essential for the service, you have the right to

withdraw your consent to this data processing at any time. However, please be

aware that this may limit the services we can provide you with where processing

personal data is essential for the service.

2. About Us

3. Information that We May Collect

We will collect information you provide to us when you subscribe to receive information about news, offers or promotions that we may run from time to time. This information might include your name, address, email address, phone number and other social networking addresses. By providing us with this information you consent to us processing it for the purposes of providing you services.

4. Use of Your Personal information

By submitting your personal details to our mailing list, where you give us your consent to do so, we will maintain contact with you about Mooncat news, publications and other related matters. We will only contact you with information we consider to be in your legitimate interest as a subscriber to our mailing list. You can opt out of receiving such communications at any time.

We do not share your personal information with any third-party other than for the purposes set out at paragraph 6 (Storage & Retention).

If you volunteer to take part in a survey, we may retain information to help improve our website and to ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner.

Your information will only be processed to the extent necessary and stored for no longer than is necessary for us to meet these purposes.

5. Cookies

We use cookies to ensure that you get the most out of our site. Cookies are small text files stored on the device you use to access the website. Cookies allow us to monitor your use of the software and simplify your use of the site.

If you do not wish for cookies to be installed on your device, you can change the settings on your browser or device to reject cookies. 6. Storage & Retention
