There is no other book in the world that, when quoted, brings tangible, life-changing results except the Bible. Nothing else can bring the supernatural into the natural with such wonderful results...except the Bible. Quotes can be spoken from other books or written things that may bring *certain* results, sure, but even the best of those are really just using the principles set in the Bible from long ago. "Positive confessions" are what some call it now, but this is a formula set thousands of years ago in the Old Testament:

This book of the law shall not withdraw from your **mouth**; but you shall **meditate** on it day and night... **then** you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

This passage is from Joshua 1:8 and it explicitly says that the word of God should not withdraw from our mouths. Usually you see the word "depart" in other translations rather than "withdraw" but the original word doesn't mean that you *can't say* the word of God from your mouth, it means to not let it stop flowing **from** your mouth. The passage then goes on to say that we should "meditate" on it day and night. Meditate here doesn't mean to think about it while on a yoga mat in some impressive position. It actually means to "speak" or "mutter." Sometimes it can even mean "roar." Speaking the word of God is vital. We know this because then the verse continues by saying "then you will make your way prosperous...then you will have good success"

Letting the Word of God flow from your mouth day and night causes YOU to make YOUR way prosperous! And using the pure Word of God will bring good results, not selfish. Nothing else in all of the earth can do that!

God's Word is Alive and sharper than we can imagine! It cuts through the junk and the muck. It brings Life...and Results!

# ~ a little origin story ~

I originally made this "book of Seeds" for my personal use. It wasn't even a book then. It was just me being done with the way things had always been, making a list of Scriptures to begin confessing over my life, and then stepping out in faith in the Word of God and putting it to work. I was tired of seeing all this goodness in the Word of God yet never (or rarely ever) attaining it. And I was equally as tired of hearing the same excuses we've all heard as to why it never came to pass in our lives. So many people not getting there. None of them living life the way Jesus said He came for us to live, nor experiencing that abundant life He said is ours in Him, and none of them (including myself for way too long) willing to stop long enough and ask "Why?"

Well, finally, I did ask. And the more I searched, the more I realized that I had been doing it wrong the whole time (*or, more accurately, not "doing" anything at all*).

I was encouraged to start "sowing the Word" in my life daily so, *long story short*, I began putting together a few parts here and other parts there and turned them into confessions from the Word of God to see what would grow.

I have to be honest with you, it was kind of a test to see if the Word really is "living, active, and sharper than any two edged sword..." (from Hebrews 4). Because if it's not, then what in the world are we doing even calling ourselves Christians? If the Word isn't just as alive, having just as much real-life, kinetic potential in/for our lives today as it purports to have done in the past, then why bother? Floating through life saying I belonged to the only True God, the Most Holy One, the Miraculous One wasn't enough for me if there were no tangible results. How could I trust the "after earth-life" to Him if I couldn't trust Him with His good promises for the here and now? But, in my heart I KNEW God was True, Just, Holy, and Perfect. There was NO way His Word had fizzled out. It just couldn't be. So, I compiled and collected, and that collection grew. I added more. Then some more after that. This verse went along with that verse. These sections shed light on those. And so on.

As time went on, it grew to many "Seeds" with different themes. The more I worked on it, the more the Lord gave to me. But even while I worked on it, I still wasn't "planting" it properly in my own life (*I want to be real with you*). Sometimes it would be days or weeks before I would do any "planting" of my own. I got caught up in compiling rather than planting it for me. Both were necessary, but I'd dropped one.

Eventually, I became **\$0** frustrated with seeing all the good in the Word yet lacking a feasting-harvest from it. I finally had enough of watching others' influence lead many to nothing more than some old merchandise *they no longer cared about* and hours of video-

viewing only to see those same influencers fall from grace or worse...being found to be complete frauds leaving their followers with old church-merch, faded bumper-stickers, books that became side-table coasters, and nothing more for their...Life.

Somehow that pushed me enough to determine in myself that I would start "Working the Word" for myself. No matter what anyone else's story was going to be, I was going to speak these Scriptures out and I wasn't going to stop. Then, if it really is as dead as so many acted and lived like it was, then so be it. This one was on God Himself and up to Him to show just how faithful (or not) He is (or isn't). But I was going to prove it, one way or the other.

"Then what happened?" you may ask.

Well I found, without realizing it at first, my thinking was changing. My outlook on every day life issues was changing. The way I handled things started changing. My perspective changed. I felt less stress. I had more energy. I was more productive and stronger. The more I Planted the Seeds, the better life got. Oh, and Peace! The peace I started having in my own headspace and in my heart. Even my body was feeling the effects of that supernatural Peace, and this was regardless of what was going on around me.

Then, just as effortlessly, all of this inward change grew from *in* my own self to seeing things change *around* me. Tangible things were happening. Even when I thought it might not work *that good* for certain issues, it Did. And Better than I thought possible!

Oh the goodness that grew in my life and continues to grow! Glory to God forever and ever! He is true! His Word is true! He is faithful, and His promises truly are our "armor and protection" (*from Psalm 91*).

I can hardly wait for you to get this working in your life! I want you to experience a life of sowing the Word of God in your life and seeing what He will grow! If you won't give up, you are going to be amazed!!



# Gardening Instructions a recipe for supernatural success

In this book, each chapter is filled with "Seeds" for each theme. They each begin with "Enter..." followed by that chapter's theme. The idea is for you to take the chapter you choose and read each Seed out loud. At the end, there is a section that says;



These confessions are kind of like covering a seed with dirt after planting it in the ground. It's meant to speak out that you are agreeing with God regarding His Word.

If you have lots of time, "plant" all the chapters in a day. It takes less time than watching a movie. If you don't have much time, plant a chapter or two, or have your own sections ready to go. For me, I like to get up earlier than I normally would just to spend time with the Lord, in Speak Plant Harvest and/or the Bible, and also in prayer. If I have enough time I'll do all eight chapters, but, I'll be real with you, sometimes that just does not work. So, I'll pick what feels right for that moment. Other days, I'll just do one chapter. I would like to point out here that, since there are eight chapters, there is enough to do one chapter a day and two on Sundays!

Also, on **page 46** there is an "**On-the-Go Seeds**" section for really busy days. That page has a little Seed from each chapter and only takes about 5 minutes to plant. Check it out. Also, the "On-the-Go" page is available for you to download and print. # ENTER THE SHEPHERD

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. This One was in the beginning with God. Through Him all things were made, and not even one thing was made without Him. In Him was life, and that life was the light of men, and the light shined in the darkness, and the darkness did not overtake it. *from John 1:1-5* 

Open to me the gate of righteousness that I may enter and give thanks to the Lord. This is the gate to the Lord that the righteous enter. I thank You that You have payed attention to me and have become my salvation. *from Psalm 118:19-21*

# **ENTER RIGHTEOUSNESS**

All of us, like sheep, have gone astray. We have turned every one to our own way; but the LORD has laid on him (*Jesus*) the sins of us all. *from Isaiah 53:6* 

...he (*Jesus*) carried our sins in His own body up to the Cross, so that we, having died to sins, can now live in righteousness: by whose bleeding stripe you were healed. *from 1 Peter 2:24* 

I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness comes through the Law, then Christ died needlessly. *from Galatians 2:21* 

#### Jesus says:

The stone that the builders rejected has now been made the cornerstone. This is the Lord's doing, and it is amazing to see. from Matthew 21:42 (He's referencing a prophecy written of Himself from Psalm 118)

Lord, let all of us be joyful who put our trust in You; Let us forever shout for joy, because You defend us. Let us also who love Your name be joyful in You. For You, O Lord, bless the righteous; You surround and protect us with Your favor as a shield. *from Psalm 5:11-12* 

We ask God Almighty to give you <u>complete</u> knowledge of His will and to give you spiritual wisdom and understanding.

<u>Then</u> the way you live will always honor and please the Lord, and your lives will produce every good deed, all while growing to know God better and better.

We also pray that you will be strengthened with **all** of His glorious power so you will have all the endurance and patience you need. May you be *filled* with joy, <u>always</u> thanking Abba Father. He has enabled you to share in the inheritance that belongs to His people, who live in <u>The Light</u>. For He has **rescued** us from the jurisdiction of darkness <u>and transferred us into</u> the Kingdom of His beloved Son, who purchased our freedom and forgave our sins.

Christ Jesus is the visible image of the invisible God. He (*Christ*) existed before anything was created and is Supreme over all creation, for <u>through Him</u> God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see — such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the seen and unseen worlds.

Everything was created through Him and for Him (*Jesus*). He existed before anything else, and He holds all things together.

Christ is also the head of the Church, which is His body. He is the beginning, supreme over all who rise from the dead. He is first in everything. For God in all of His fullness was pleased to live in Christ, and, **through Him, God reconciled everything to Himself**. He made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of

#### Christ's blood on the cross.

#### This includes **YOU**

who were once far away from God. You *were* His enemies, separated from Him by your evil thoughts and actions. **Yet** now He has reconciled you to Himself through the death of His Son - Jesus Christ - in His physical body.

As a result, He has brought you into His own presence, and <u>you are</u> **holy** <u>and</u> **blameless** as you stand before Him, *the Holy One of Israel*,

## without a single fault.

But you <u>must</u> continue to believe this truth and <u>stand firmly in it</u>. Do not drift away from the assurance you received when you heard <u>this</u> Good News. from Colossians 1:9-23



<u>All</u> of <u>this</u> is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through <u>Christ Jesus</u> and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.

God was reconciling the world to Himself in Christ Jesus, not counting people's sins against them. And He has committed to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us. So we implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

God made Him (*Jesus*) who had <u>no</u> sin to <u>be</u> sin **for** us, so that **in Him** (*Jesus*) we might become the righteousness of God. from 2 Corinthians 5:18-21

Let your eyes look directly ahead and let your gaze be set straight in front of you. Watch the path of your feet\* and all your ways will be firm. Don't turn to the right or to the left; Turn your foot from evil. *from Proverbs 4:25-27 \*Feet that have the shoes of the gospel of Peace with God (See Ephesians 6:15)* 

#### Jesus says:

But you seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. *from Matthew 6:33* 

Whoever goes after righteousness and mercy finds; **life**, **righteousness**, and **honor**. *from Proverbs 21:21* 

For the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking; but <u>righteousness</u>, <u>peace</u>, and <u>joy</u> in the Holy Ghost. *from Romans 14:17* 

In <u>righteousness</u> you are established; you shall be <u>very far</u> from oppression, injury, fraud and distress for you shall not fear or be frightened; and from terror, <u>for it shall not</u> come near or approach you. *from Isaiah 54:14* 



I am the Righteousness of the Most High God in Christ Jesus. This is established. I am blessed with, and receive, every good thing the Living God of Israel Himself has given to me because of Jesus Christ's <u>finished</u> work. No good thing is withheld from me. Oppression, injury, fraud, and distress are very far from me. I do not fear and I cannot be frightened. Terror shall not come near or approach me.

In Jesus' name, the highest name, and by His Blood, amen.





# **ENTER WISDOM**

Blessed is the one who finds wisdom, and the one who gets understanding, for that is better than the gain from silver and the profit is better than gold. Wisdom is more precious than jewels, and nothing you desire can compare. In wisdom's right hand is long life. In wisdom's left hand are riches and honor. All of wisdom's ways are pleasant, and all wisdom's paths are peace. Wisdom is a tree of life to those who lay hold of it.

Those who hold wisdom tight are called blessed. from Proverbs 3:13-18

Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all you acquire get understanding. *from Proverbs 4:7* 

#### Wisdom says:

I love those who love me; And those who seek me with their whole heart will find me. Riches and honor are with me, lasting wealth and righteousness. My fruit is better than gold, even pure gold. And my yield better than choicest silver. I walk in the way of righteousness, in the middle of the paths of justice, to give wealth to those who love me, that I may fill their treasuries. *from Proverbs 8:17-21* 

Trust the LORD with all of your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will direct your paths. Don't be wise in your own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. It will be health to your navel, and marrow to your bones. *from Proverbs 3:5-8* 

Wisdom illuminates a person's face... from Ecclesiastes 8:1

For the Lord gives wisdom. Out of His mouth comes knowledge and understanding. He lays up sound wisdom for the righteous. He is a **shield** to those that walk upright. He keeps the paths of judgment, and preserves the way of His saints. Therefore you will understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity. Yes, every good path. When wisdom enters your heart and knowledge is pleasant to your soul, discretion will protect you, and understanding will keep you safe. To <u>deliver you</u> from:

- 1. the way of the evil person,
- 2. the one that speaks perverse things
- 3. those who leave the right paths to walk in the ways of darkness
- 4. those who rejoice to do evil and take delight in the perverseness of the wicked, and
- 5. [those] whose ways are crooked and perverse in their paths. from Proverbs 2:6-15

If any of you are deficient in wisdom, ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given. from James 1:5

"Dear Lord, I ask you to generously give me Your Wisdom, in Jesus' holy name, amen"

God has united you with Christ Jesus.

For our benefit God made Jesus to be **wisdom** for us from Himself. **Christ** made us right with God. He made us pure and holy, and He freed us from sin. *from 1 Corinthians 1:30* 

Let the word of **Christ**, in all of its richness, fill your lives to overflowing. Teach and counsel each other with all the **wisdom** <u>He gives</u>. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts. *from Colossians 3:16* 

...I want their hearts to be encouraged, being knit together in love, and having all the riches of the complete confidence and understanding of the mystery of God

— Christ — in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

from Colossians 2:2

For who has known the mind of the Lord to give Him advice? **But**, we have the mind of **Christ**. *from 1 Corinthians 2:16* 



I have the mind of Christ, who is Himself Wisdom.

Because I am in Him and He is in me, I do not lack any good thing. I ask for and receive the perfect wisdom of the Most High God in and for my life. He gives me the mind of Christ. In Jesus' holy name, and by His Blood, amen.





# **ENTER POWER & AUTHORITY**



God of our Lord Jesus Christ, Father of glory, I ask You to give me, [speak out names of those you also want to pray this for] the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. May the eyes of our hearts be enlightened, so that we may know:

- \* the hope to which You have called us,
- \* the riches of Your glorious inheritance in the saints, and
- \* the immeasurable greatness of Your power toward us who believe, according to the working of Your great might that You worked in Christ when You raised Him from the dead and seated Him at Your right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. And You put all things under His feet and gave Him as head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

—and I ask—

that You would grant me [and all those I named], according to the riches of Your glory, to be strengthened with miraculous power by Your Spirit in our inner selves; so Christ may house permanently in our hearts by faith that we will be rooted and grounded in love, and that we may be able to grasp with all the saints what is the width, and length, and depth, and height, and that we will know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge so that we can be filled with all the fullness of You.

—Thank You that—

You, God, being <u>rich</u> in mercy, because of Your <u>Great love</u> that You love us with, even when we were dead in our transgressions (*sins*), You made us <u>alive</u> together with <u>Christ</u> —by grace we have been saved— <u>and</u> You raised us up with Him, <u>and seated</u> us <u>with Him</u> in the heavenly places in <u>Christ Jesus!</u>

to You who is able to do **exceedingly**, abundantly, and over and above, those things that we are asking for and thinking about, to **You** be glory in the church by **Christ Jesus** throughout all the ages, forever and ever...Amen!

praying the word

from Ephesians 1:16-23, 3:16-19, 2:4-6, and then 3:20-21

Combined & Personalized, I call this "The Ephesians Power Prayer"

As you received Christ Jesus the Lord, live in Him, rooted and built up in Him, strong and stable in your faith, just as you were taught,\* and overflowing in gratitude.

from Colossians 2:6-7 (\*by the Holy Spirit and the Word of God)

#### • What Jesus said to satan:

Go away Satan! For it is written and is on record, you shall worship the Lord your God, and you shall **only** serve Him. *from Matthew 4:10* 

#### What Jesus says to me:

Look, I have given you the authority over <u>all</u> the power of the enemy, and you can walk among snakes and scorpions and crush them. **Absolutely Nothing will hurt you**. *from Luke 10:19* 

God <u>did not</u> give us a spirit of timidity or fear, but of miraculous power, and of love, and of a sound mind. *from 2 Timothy 1:7* 

Be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his mighty power. Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all of the cunning arts and stratagems\* of the devil; that slanderous, falsely-accusing, evil one.

For we are <u>not</u> fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against <u>evil rulers and authorities of</u> the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the <u>heavenly places</u>. <u>Because of this</u>, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then, after the battle, you will still be standing firm...

# Stand your ground,

putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness.

For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared.

#### Adding to all of these,

hold up the shield of faith to quench ALL the flaming missiles, spears and arrows of the evil. Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, by all prayer, asking, and seeking in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion,

Staying alert and being persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere.

# **ENTER PROTECTION**

**NO** weapon formed against you will push forward. You will condemn every tongue raised up to charge you. This is the inheritance of the servants of the Lord; their righteousness in me. I, the LORD, have spoken. *from Isaiah 54:17* 

The Lord of Heaven's Armies is right here with us; the God of Israel is our refuge. *from Psalms 46:11* 

And I will be a wall of fire all around, declares the LORD, and I will be the glory in the center. *from Zechariah 2:5* 

The Lord himself guards you with His protection! The Lord himself stands beside you as your protective shade. The sun <u>absolutely will not</u> strike you by day, nor the moon at night.

The Lord protects you from <u>all</u> harm <u>and</u> guards and protects your life.

**The Lord** guards you with His protection as you come and go, both now and always.

from Psalm 121:5-8

Those who live in the shelter of the Most High will <u>find rest</u> in the shadow of the Almighty. <u>This I say about the Lord</u>:

— He <u>alone</u> is my refuge, He is my place of safety; He is my God, and I trust Him.

For **He will** rescue you from every trap and <u>protect you from all deadly disease</u>. **He will** cover you with His feathers. **He will** shelter you with His wings. **His <u>faithful</u>** promises are your armor and protection. **Do not be afraid** of the terrors of night, nor of the arrow that flies in the day.

**Do not dread** the disease that sneaks in darkness, nor the disaster that strikes at midday. Even though a thousand fall at your side, even though ten thousand are dying around you, **these evils will not touch you**. You will see, *only with your eyes*, the retribution of the wicked.

If you choose to make the Lord your refuge, if you choose to make the Most High your shelter, **absolutely no evil** will conquer you; **no plague** will come near your home. For **He will** order His angels to protect you wherever you go. **They will** hold you up with their hands so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone. **You will** trample upon lions and cobras; **you will** crush fierce lions and serpents under your feet!

\*Shalom:

In righteousness you are established; you shall be **very far** from oppression, injury, fraud and distress for <u>you shall not fear or be frightened</u>; **and** from terror, for it <u>shall not come near or approach you</u>. *from Isaiah 54:14* 

May God himself, the God of shalom peace, sanctify you completely. May your **entire** spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The one who calls you is <u>faithful</u>, **and He will do it**. from 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

Jesus says to the Father:

# **ENTER HEALING**

He (*Jesus*) personally <u>carried</u> our sins in his body on the <u>cross</u> so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. **By His** stripes **you** <u>are</u> cured, healed and made whole. You were like sheep that wandered away from safety and the truth, but now you've turned back to <u>the</u> <u>Shepherd</u> and Overseer of your soul, your life's breath . *from 1 Peter 2:24-25* 

Bless the Lord my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name and position. Bless the Lord my soul, and do not be oblivious to His **whole** treatments:

- \* He forgives you of **all** perversity and sins,
- \* He mends, cures and heals you from **all** diseases and sicknesses;
- \* He redeems your life from the pit, destruction and grave,
- \* He <u>crowns</u> you with covenant kindness and compassion;
- \* He fills you continually with good; your youth is rebuilt like the eagle. *from Psalm 103:1-5*

"Dearest loved ones, I pray that in **every** way you may continually succeed and prosper and be in good health, just as your soul prospers. *from 3 John 1:2* 

That evening they brought to him (*Jesus*) many who were oppressed by demons, and He cast out the spirits with a word <u>and</u> healed **ALL** who were sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah: "<u>He took my feebleness, lifted and removed malady.</u>" *from Matthew 8:16-17* 

Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today, and forever. from Hebrews 13:8

He (*The Lord*) shall bless your bread and water. I, the Lord, will also <u>remove sickness</u> from among you. No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren; I will fulfill the number of your days. I will send My terror ahead of you, and I will throw into confusion everyone you come to and I will make all your enemies turn their backs to you and run away. *from Exodus 23:25-27* 

And they cry to Jehovah in their adversity, and <u>He saves them</u> from their distresses. He sends His word and <u>heals them</u>, and <u>delivers them</u> from their destructions. They confess to Jehovah His kindness, and His wonders to everyone. They sacrifice <u>sacrifices of thanksgiving</u>, and tell of His works with shouting, rejoicing and singing. *from Psalm 107:19-22* 

Those who live in the shelter of the Most High will <u>find rest</u> in the shadow of the Almighty. <u>This I say about the Lord</u>:

— He <u>alone</u> is my refuge, He is my place of safety; He is my God, and I trust Him.

For **He will** rescue you from every trap and <u>protect you from all deadly disease</u>. **He will** cover you with His feathers. **He will** shelter you with His wings. **His <u>faithful promises</u>** are your armor and protection. **Do not be afraid** of the terrors of night, nor of the arrow that flies in the day. **Do not dread** the disease that sneaks in darkness, nor the disaster that strikes at midday. Even though a thousand fall at your side, even though ten thousand are dying around you, <u>these evils will not touch you</u>. You will see, *only with your eyes*, the retribution of the wicked. If you choose to make the Lord your refuge, if you choose to make the Most High your shelter,

If you choose to make the Lord your refuge, if you choose to make the Most High your shelter, absolutely no evil will conquer you; no plague will come near your home. For He will order His angels to protect you wherever you go. They will hold you up with their hands so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone. You will trample upon lions and cobras; you will crush fierce lions and serpents under your feet!

This is what the Lord says:

"I will rescue those who love me. I will protect those who trust in my name. When they call on me, I will answer; I will be with them in trouble. I will rescue and honor them.
 I will reward them with a long blessed life and show them my salvation." from Psalm 91

...Pay close attention to my words, and open your ears to what I say.

Do not let them escape from your sight; Keep them in the center of your heart.

For they are <u>life</u> to those who find them, and <u>healing</u> and <u>health</u> to <u>all</u> of their flesh.

Watch over your heart with all diligence, for from it flows the springs of life. Put away from you a deceitful, lying and misleading mouth. Put devious lips far from you. Let your eyes look directly ahead. Let your gaze be fixed straight in front of you. Consider well and watch carefully the path of your feet, then all your ways will be firm and sure. Do not turn away to the right or to the left. Turn your foot from the path of evil. *from Proverbs 4:20-27* 

Oh Lord,

...Revive and nourish my life according to Your word. from Psalms 119:25b

Jesus says:

If you live in me, and <u>my words</u> live in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you. *from John 15:7* 

The Holy One of Israel says;

I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you today, that I have set before you <u>life</u> and <u>death</u>, the <u>blessing</u> and the <u>curse</u>; therefore, <u>choose life</u> so that <u>you may live</u>, you <u>and</u> your descendants, by loving the Lord your God, by obeying His voice, and by holding closely to Him. For <u>He is your life</u>. He is your <u>good life</u>...your <u>abundant life</u>. *from Deuteronomy 30:19-20* 

Jesus says:

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have <u>life</u>, and have it abundantly, to the fullest until it overflows. *from John 10:10* 

There is <u>not even one</u> bit of condemnation against those who are in **Christ Jesus**, for **the law of the Spirit of <u>life</u> in Christ Jesus** has <u>set you free</u> from the law of sin and of death. *from Romans 8:1-2* 

A man's stomach will be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; He will be satisfied with the produce of his words. <u>Death</u> and <u>LIFE</u> are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit. *from Proverbs* 18:20-21

Let the sayings of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, Be a pleasing thing before You, O Jehovah, my rock, and my redeemer! *from Psalms 19:14* 

Is anyone among you sick? Then call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord:

And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise them up; and if they have committed sins, they shall be forgiven. *from James 5:14-15* 

#### Jesus says:

Have faith in God constantly. **Truly** I tell you, whoever <u>says</u> to this mountain, 'Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!' and does not doubt in his heart but instead believes that what he <u>says</u> will take place, it will <u>surely</u> be done for him. For this reason I am telling you, <u>whatever you ask for in prayer</u>, believe and be confident that it is granted to you, and **you will get it.** *from Mark* 11:22-24

<u>Christ purchased our freedom</u> and <u>redeemed us from the curse of the Law and its</u> condemnation because He <u>became</u> a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree"— in <u>Christ Jesus</u> the blessing of Abraham also comes to the Gentiles, so we <u>all</u> receive the promise of the Holy Spirit through faith. *from Galatians 3:13-14* 

Have you not known that your body is a <u>temple of the Holy Spirit in you</u>, whom you have from God? You are not your own. You were <u>bought with a price</u>. So, glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are all God's. *from 1 Corinthians 6:19-20* 

What union can there be between God's temple and idols? For <u>we are</u> the temple of the living God. As God said: "I will live <u>in</u> them and walk among them. I will be their God, and they will be my people." *from 2 Corinthians 6:16* 

If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give <u>life</u> to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you. *from Romans 8:11* 

Little children (*believers in Christ Jesus*), you are <u>of</u> God and you belong <u>to</u> Him and have already overcome the agents of the antichrist because He who is <u>in you</u> is **greater** than he (*satan*) who is in the world. *from 1 John 4:4* 

The Holy One of Israel says;

"Rescue him from the grave, for I have found a ransom for his life."

His body will become as healthy as a child's, firm and youthful again. When he prays to God, he will be accepted. And God will receive him with joy and restore him to good standing.

He will then declare to his friends, "I sinned and twisted the truth, but it was not worth it. God Himself rescued me from the grave, and now my life is filled with light."

"Yes, God does these things again and again for people. He rescues them from the grave so they may enjoy the light of life. from Job 33:24-30

#### Jesus says:

The generous soul shall be made rich: and the one that waters shall be watered also himself. 
