Respondent

has been stalking the petitioner since October 2007. The respondent has been harassing and stalking the petitioner by e-mail and blogging accusations about the petitioner and the respondent's wife. The petitioner has never had a relationship with the respondents wife, but the respondent has been persistent in notifying various offices within the police department of the so-called affair. The petitioner does not know why the respondent is accusing him but this is harmful to the petitioner's reputation on the department and dangerous because the petitioner has never seen the respondent so he is very leery when approached by persons not familiar to him. The petitioner does not know if the respondent has ever seen him or not. The respondent has even gone as far as filing an official complaint against the petitioner on April 9, 2008 with the police department in regards to this. It appears the respondent could be suffering from a mental health issue based on some of his writings involving this situation. People within the department have come up to the petitioner telling him they have seen what the respondent is writing about the him. On April 9, the respondent has requested the police department furnish him with personal information about the petitioner, information that is not public and the respondent is not entitled to have about anyone. The respondent has accused the petitioner of constantly harassing him and his family. The respondent has also accused the petitioner of raping his wife.
