SPRUCE TRAILS


Located on Hwy 410 (Dorset Trail) approximately 4 kms from Baie Verte in central Newfoundland is the Spruce Trails Snowshoeing Association trail system. The trail system is 4.2 km long.



Spruce Trails began around 1985 as a cross country skiing facility. A hut was constructed during the 1987-88 season which has undergone major improvements in the past 5 years.

With a decline in membership the trail conditions declined. In 2009 the trails were reopened for snowshoeing. The trail passes through scenic forest and includes several small ponds and streams to cross. Various wildlife, including moose, fox, and coyotes, use the trails but are seldom seen.





As this site is subject to an Agreement in partnership with Spruce Trails Snowshoeing Association, we are committed to supporting local recreational activities, and have committed to consult with the Association during preparation of Five Year Management Plans when proposed forest management activities are in the vicinity of the existing trail network. It is our commitment to locals to allow recreation to continue on the trail system.
