



## The Crazy House Analogy






To support a **Culture of Reliability** and to create future business value, we need to drive for simplification



## Collaboration: Videoconferencing

#### Videoconferencing rooms/equipment available in:

#### Usage is growing

- Jan 2016: 28 vs Nov 2016: 185 (Dec 2016: 108)
- To date 1,947 videoconferences hosted with 3,451 participants

#### 2017 Plans

- 6 additional locations planned (fixed & portable)
- High definition SfB one button videoconferences

#### Future vision

Simple, accessible videoconferencing for everyone at Methanex

#### Microsoft Office

- Excel, PowerPoint, Word, Outlook
- Evergreen always working on latest version
- Updates released regularly > incremental, constant change
- Office suite available in cloud
- Enables online editing & data manipulation
- 2016: IT users testing
- 1<sup>st</sup> half 2017: Rollout to global teams
- 2<sup>nd</sup> half 2017: Rollout to rest of organization (based on usage)





### Collaboration: Global Content Management Strategy

- 45+ technologies used globally\*
- 63% of employees have difficulties finding information\*
- GCMS is developing strategy & framework to enable:
  - Access to files from any device, anywhere & anytime
  - Real time co-editing
  - Version control
- Pilot with Corporate Development wraps up early 2017
- Build out collaboration sites on SharePoint through 2017
- Due to scope of project, project is also governed by a steering committee

- Richer, more seamless experience




