# Hourly employees FAQs



## Do I have to use the same clock each & every time?

No, our mills have more than one clock. You can clock in & out at any clock at your mill.

## Do I have to clock in & out for my breaks & lunch?

No, you only need to clock in at the beginning & end of your shift.



Do I have to clock in & out if I physically leave the site during a shift? Yes.

## What happens if I forget to clock in or out?

This is known as a missed punch.

Your supervisor will see this as an exception on your timecard. Your supervisor will discuss with you & can adjust your time manually in your timecard.


# Hourly employees FAQs



## I'd like to be able to see my schedule on my mobile device – is this possible?

Yes, you can access your work schedule, see your timecard build in real time & request vacation time off via the **UKG Workforce Central** app.

It's a free app available from your app store:



Ask your supervisor for a job aid on how to log into this app.

#### **NOTE:**

The app is **not** used to clock in & out. The 'physical' timeclocks are used for time capture.

## When is my first pay in the Canfor payroll system?

### When is my pay statement available?

Pay statements are available to view the Thursday prior to your Friday pay day
