He also mentioned signups for NCAA pool and explained about winning.


We sang "That's Amore" lead by Chris Zavoda and Vince Martell

- The Scholarship Committee thanks you for your continued support of our scholarship fundraising efforts, especially for your help in paying dues as this is a critical component of funding our scholarships.








February Balance was \$ 36,992

March Balance is \$38,733










Benvenuto.!!

I am <u>Giacomo Belinimi</u>, discoverer of the source of the Mississippi River in 1823. (Lake Itasca, Minnesota)






I created the Dome of the United States Capitol. They call me the Michelangelo of America. I am **Constantino Brumidi**.







In 1904, I founded in San Francisco the Bank of Italy--now known as the Bank of America--the largest financial institution in the world. I am **A.P. Giannini.**




