Steve talked about and showed a video about Cinque Terre in Italy. Sal Saladini further commented on this area.

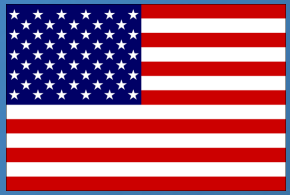
Mike talked about upcoming Wild Rose Dance on 5/11 and Ballgame at Patriot's Stadium on 6/22.

He also mentioned signups for NCAA pool and explained about winning.

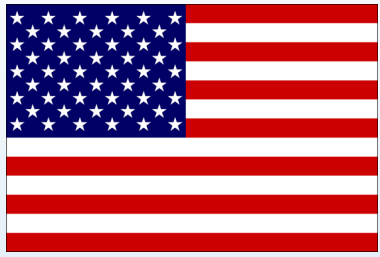
We sang "That's Amore" lead by Chris Zavoda and Vince Martell

Mike adjourned the meeting at 7:45pm

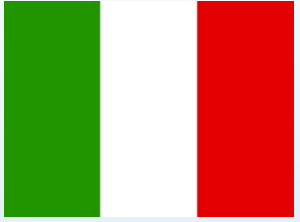


IACC 2024 Scholarship Update

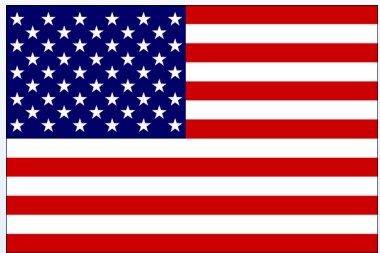

I created the Dome of the United States Capitol. They call me the Michelangelo of America. I am **Constantino Brumidi**.



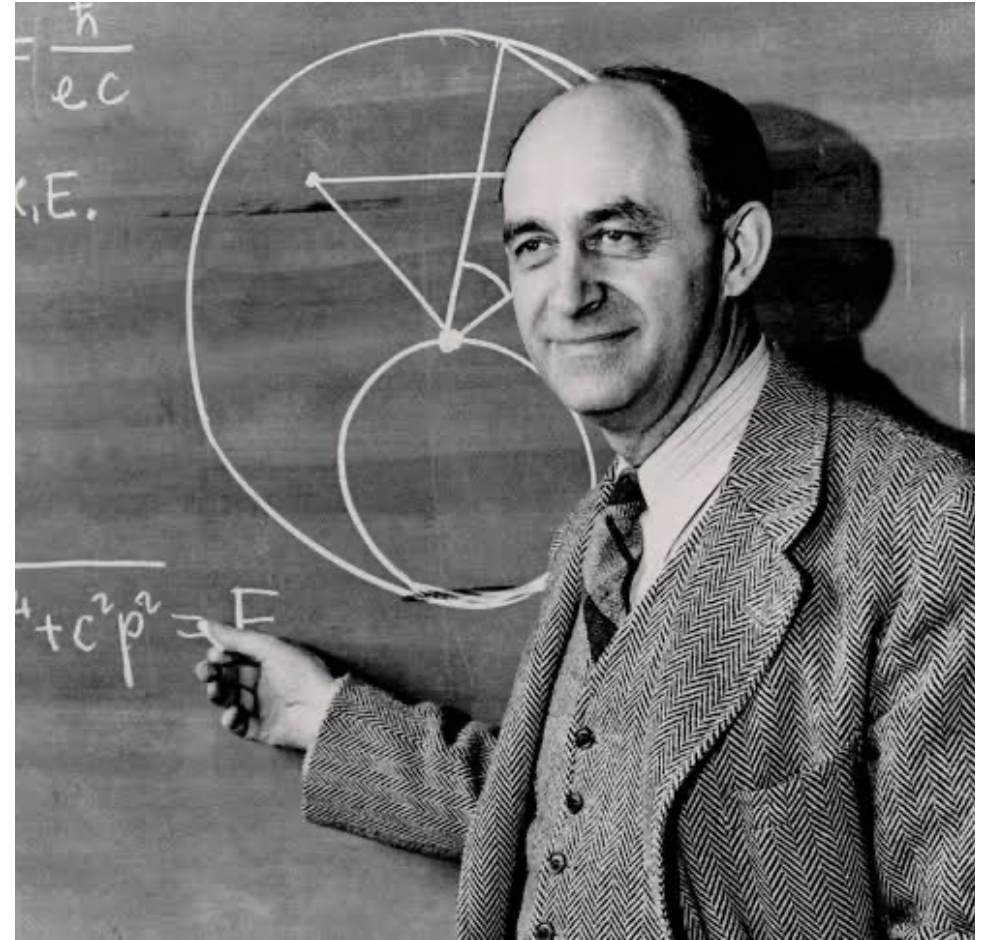
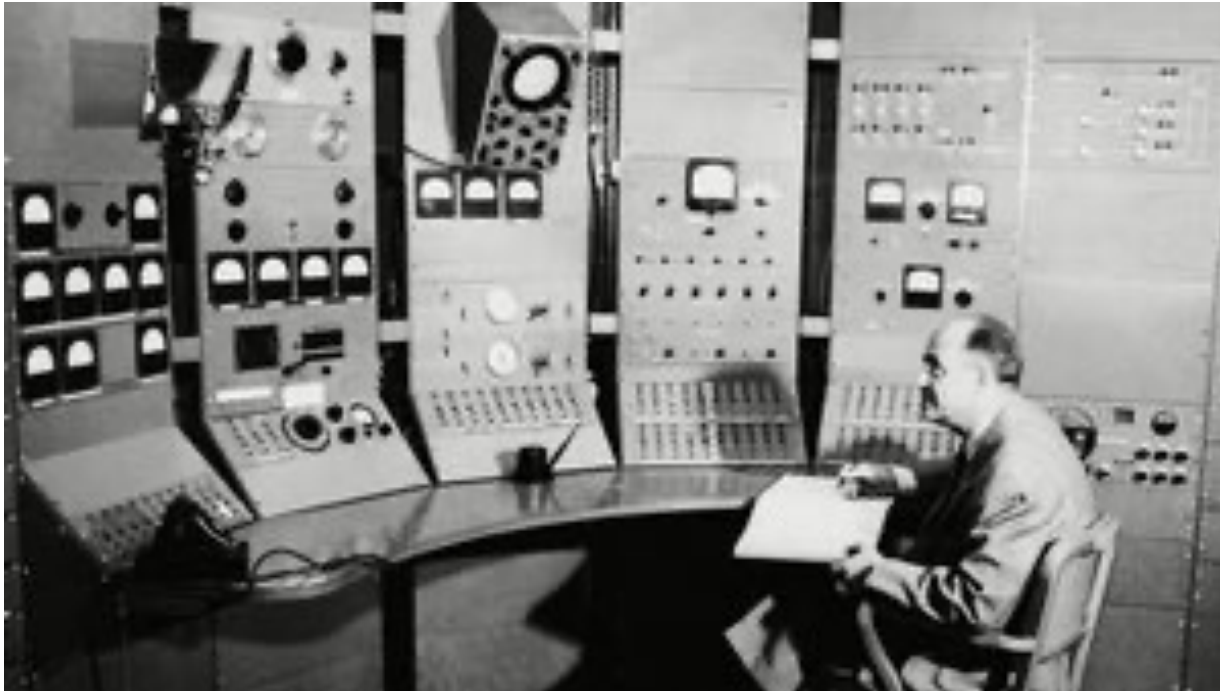
I Am An Italian American
