We all sang That's Amore

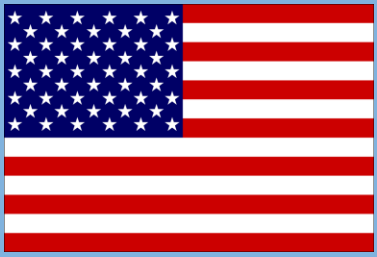

IACC 2025 Scholarship Update

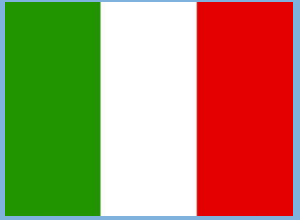

- The Scholarship Committee thanks you for your continued support of our scholarship fundraising efforts, especially for your help in paying dues as this is a critical component of funding our scholarships.



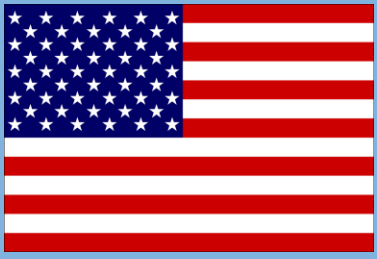

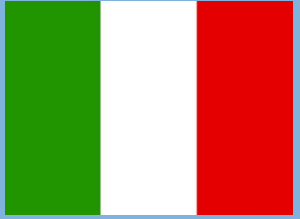
March Balance in the account was \$ 33,971

April Balance in the account \$ 34,344



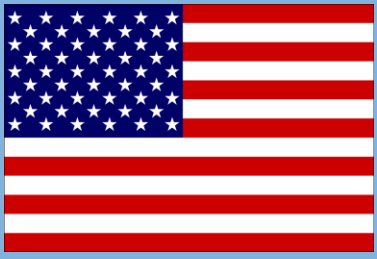

Large Expenditures



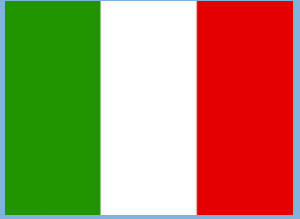

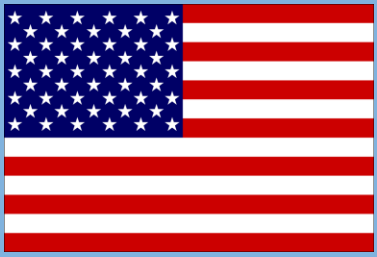

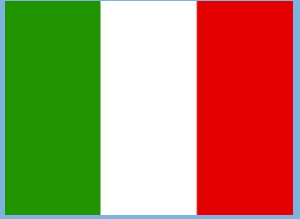


- 1) Dues- approx. \$ 5,000

World's first Highway

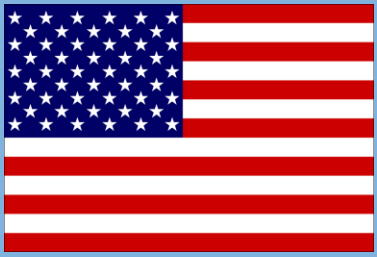


Italy is credited with building the first highway. One hundred years ago under the rule of King Vittorio Emanuele III the first section of the Autostrada dei Laghi was inaugurated.

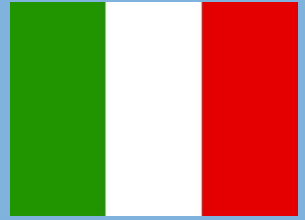
It was the first roadway for autos designed to connect two destinations while allowing rapid transit. It opened in the autumn of 1924. It is the only 5 lane highway in Italy. It connected Milan and Varese. The chief engineer was Piero Puricelli, the count of Lomnago.

It laid the foundation for every highway system in the world.





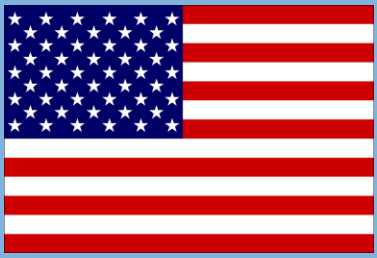
Sophia Loren

She said, "I love this city (Rome), where it all began. I arrived in Rome with my mother when I was 15 and I started working as an extra. It was a choice that changed the course of my life."





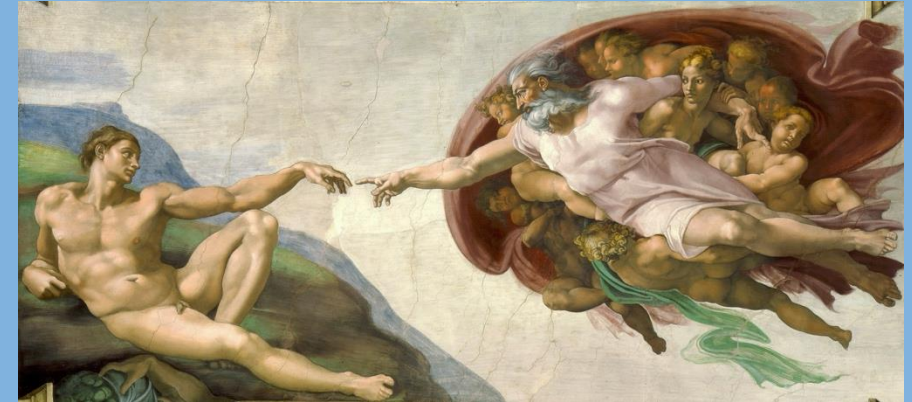

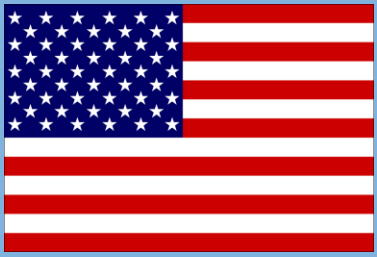

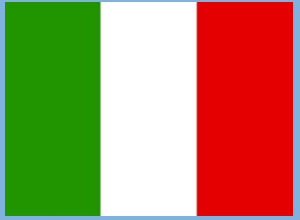
