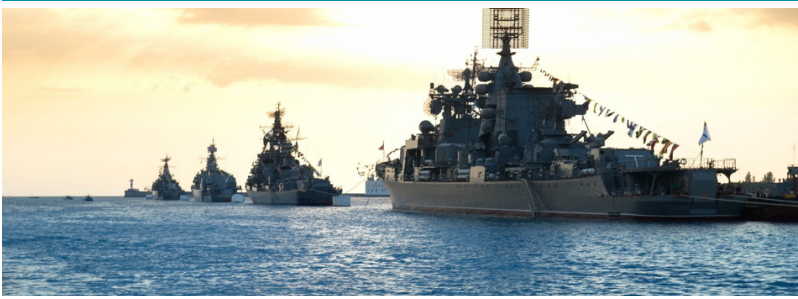

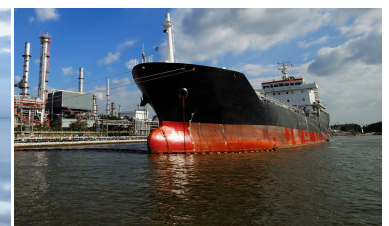
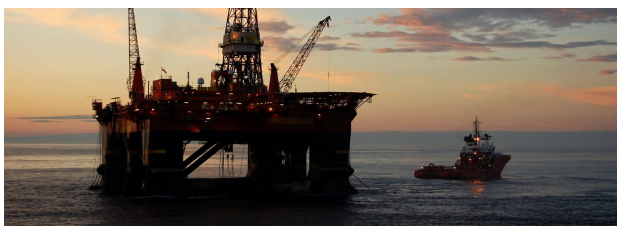
## Core Competencies and Achievements
