The Cropmaxx team has been out scouting fields and have been counting 10-20 Bertha army worms per square meter. This is the threshold of spraying so our staff urge farmers to beware! These persistent beasts have the ability to devastate crops and harm yields if left unchecked. If your fields are infected place an order for insecticides as we expect an increase in demand. Remember there are several experts in the area that can assist in identifying the best solution for your situation.

With the hot weather we also advise spraying in the morning when its cooler as the hot sun make plants less accepting of chemicals and evaporation occurs quicker.
