

Design Your Own Fabric Collection

If you have ever wanted to try your hand at creating your own unique fabric collection, here is your opportunity. This two-day workshop takes you from deciding on a color scheme and theme, to creating your own tools (stamps, tjaps, and stencils), to bringing your unique creations into reality by dyeing, painting, stamping and stenciling. Learn how to create “repeats” into your designs and how to prepare your fabric for online printing orders. Use your own unique fabric in a quilt or to create a garment. The possibilities are endless.

Class Dates: October 25-26, 2024

Class duration: two days, 9AM to 3:30PM (1/2 hour break for lunch) bring your own or order from Marla’s choice.

Class location: Marla Hattabaugh’s studio , 6339 E. Mitchell St., Scottsdale, AZ

Class cost: \$120.00 plus supply fee \$40.00. This includes 2 yds of fabric, paint, soy wax and basic supplies needed to participate in all activities. (Note: additional fabrics, paint, etc. can be purchased on site or bring your own)



Day One:

- Learn how to pick a color palette
- Find out why one “ugly” can add pop to a print
- Learn how to create simple repeats in your fabric design
- Decide on a theme for your collection
- Create tools for stamping, stenciling and batiks making.
- Dye base layers and prepare your background surfaces.

Day two:

- Use your base layers to create complex cloth designs
- Create a tone-on-tone solid
- Learn how to layer motifs to create your own unique expressions.
- Cut and apply stenciled designs to fabric

- Make a simple stamp using fun foam and use it to create a fabric design
- Learn how to prepare batik fabrics for additional design elements and how to heat set stenciled and stamped fabrics
- Learn how to prepare your designs for printing on fabric using an online printing service such as Spoonflower or Contrado.
