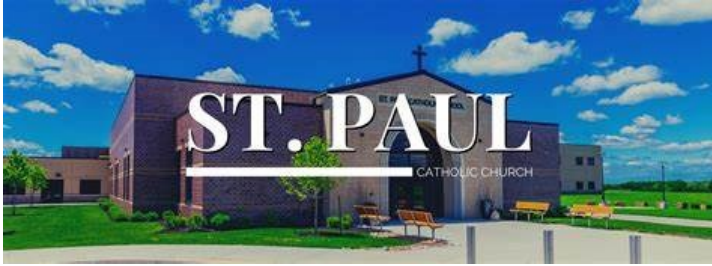
HONOR GUARD
