Top Twenty-Five Foundational Terms

1. Creator

The eternal, self-existent God who alone is uncreated. Creator brought all things into existence, sustains the cosmos, and is the source of truth, life, purpose, and reality.

2. Reality

Reality is the way things actually are, whether or not they are fully understood or acknowledged by humanity. Wisdom begins by aligning life with reality as established by the Creator.

3. Cosmos

The ordered universe created and continually sustained by the Creator.

Throughout KIG4AGK, **cosmos** refers predominantly to the physical universe but also to the arena in which history, cultures, stewardship, and God's redemptive purposes unfold.

Every new term opens another room in the Library of Discovery.



4. Masses in Motion

The continual movement and interaction of people, cultures, ideas, institutions, resources, and physical realities within Creator's cosmos.

Observing these movements reveals patterns, opportunities, responsibilities, and the consequences of human decisions.

5. Phenomenology

The disciplined practice of carefully observing reality before drawing conclusions about its meaning or causes. Throughout KIG4AGK, phenomenology encourages careful observation before interpretation.

- Scientists carefully observe the created order.
- Students of Scripture carefully observe the biblical text.

Both disciplines benefit from disciplined observation before drawing conclusions.

Observe carefully. Interpret thoughtfully. Steward wisely.

6. Creation

Everything the Creator has brought into existence, both visible and invisible. This term is all encompassing like “created order” or “cosmos” or “universe.”

7. Image of God

The unique dignity, identity, responsibility, and potential built into every human being as God's image-bearer.

8. Kingdom

The realm in which the Creator's authority, purposes, and character are recognized, embraced, and increasingly reflected.

9. Vision

A compelling picture of a preferred future that inspires long-term direction.

10. Mission

A defined assignment undertaken to advance the Vision through faithful stewardship and purposeful action.

11. Values

The enduring principles that guide decisions, relationships, priorities, and conduct.

12. Stewardship

The faithful management of everything entrusted by the Creator, including life, relationships, time, opportunities, abilities, influence, knowledge, and resources.

13. Wisdom

The ability to understand reality accurately and faithfully apply truth to everyday life.

14. Human Flourishing

The increasing experience of purpose, productive work, meaningful relationships, peace, joy, responsibility, and faithful stewardship as people live according to the Creator's design.

15. Disciple

A lifelong learner and follower of Jesus Christ who increasingly reflects His character, obeys His teachings, and participates in His mission.



16. Disciple-Making

Helping others become mature followers of Jesus Christ who faithfully help others grow as well.

17. Fellowship with Father

An ongoing personal relationship with the Creator expressed through worship, prayer, Scripture, gratitude, obedience, trust, and communion.

18. Sabbatical Cultures

The rhythms of worship, rest, reflection, renewal, and fellowship with the Creator that strengthen every other area of life.

19. Seven Cultures

The seven interrelated spheres through which every person experiences and stewards life:

- Personal
- Familial
- Occupational
- Recreational
- National
- Global
- Sabbatical

Together they form the Hulbert Seven Cultures Framework.

20. CEO of Self

CEO of Self is the personal responsibility each individual has to lead and faithfully steward the life entrusted to them under the Creator's authority.

Just as the chief executive officer is responsible for the direction, culture, and stewardship of an organization, every person serves as the "CEO" of his or her own Headquarters. Daily decisions shape character, relationships, health, learning, work, finances, influence, and legacy.

Life may be understood as a series of relationships, responsibilities, and commitments. Wise stewardship includes learning to honor those commitments with integrity, exercise sound judgment, and prepare future generations for faithful leadership.

Financial stewardship is one important responsibility among many. Developing Financial Intelligence helps individuals wisely manage resources, avoid unnecessary bondage, and increase their capacity to serve others. Yet the ultimate security of the CEO of Self rests not in wealth, but in trusting the Creator, whose faithful provision and wise counsel sustain every area of life.

A twenty-five-year initiative (2025–2049) dedicated to encouraging leadership, stewardship, productive enterprise, and national development while pursuing the long-term objective of increasing the number of Developed Nations from 38 to 100.
