On Sunday, August 10th, 2025, I took a step forward — literally — in response to God's call. That morning, after wrestling with whether to even attend church, I arrived at Valley Baptist in Bakersfield, CA and heard Pastor Andrew Spradlin preach on the Great Commission. His vision: to see Valley become a prolific church-planting, mission-sending congregation over the next decade.

When Pastor Andrew invited those called to full-time ministry to come forward, I joined others — including my friend Nolan Cooper, whom I baptized the week prior — in publicly committing to follow Christ into ministry.

This was not a new desire, but a renewed surrender. After decades of ministry service, followed by a season of personal and financial challenges, I am once again "retired into full-time ministry" — ready to invest all my energy, gifts, and resources into discipling, equipping, and sending workers into the harvest field.
