#### Welcome To Discipleship Intensive

Jesus loves humans. He wants every soul to reign with Him in glory (2 Peter 3:9). He has chosen to use His children to persuade others to now enter His Kingdom. And this ministry of disciple making is a task that He promises to fulfill through us.

To accomplish the commission, Jesus has given gifts to equip the church for world evangelization (Eph. 4:11ff, Rom. 12:6-8). These gifts are distributed by the Holy Spirit and designed to function with a group of called out ones, the *ekklesia*, the church. Thus, churches are to make disciples, and every church must have a plan for carrying out this commission.

Discipleship Intensive is a strategy that the president of Advancing God's Kingdom, Darren Hulbert, developed over years of church ministry. What you hold in your hands is a product designed to equip every believer to become a disciple-maker in his or her church. As a church becomes intense about discipleship, that body will grow exponentially. Just as the Bible says, "the church multiplied." Jesus has always done this in His church.

So, the question must be asked: Is your church following Jesus?

While Jesus builds His church through Discipleship Intensive, disciplemakers will arise to apply their skills. When pastor(s) and deacons recognize several up and coming disciple-makers in the church, that church should prepare to reproduce a new church. New churches will be established to make disciples who make disciples. Planting reproducing churches.

Just a quick thought: Do you know why Coca Cola (Coke) is much bigger than Pepsi? Simply stated, distribution. For several years, you could find a Coke vending machine almost anywhere, and only a few for Pepsi. I'm all for having a church on every corner as long as every church is producing disciple-makers.

Discipleship is intensely pursued by everyone who is called out by Jesus. Disciple making is a compulsion caused by the Holy Spirit who indwells every believer. Each needs to discover his unique expression. We now set our hearts on being disciples of Jesus Christ who learn, live, and teach the gospel of God's Kingdom. Here's how.

#### How to Use Discipleship Intensive

#### Gather a Group

Prayer

- Carefully pray for many people in your sphere of influence. Ask God to make each one receptive to His gospel.
- Begin where the ground is most fertile; look for "friendlies." Consider the 20 most receptive people.

#### Invitation

- Create an opportunity for inviting each person to participate in a small group that is going to radically empower their lives for eternity.
- Make the invitation personally, one on one, face to face that is fine. And if you can invite the group at one time, do that. Whatever it takes!
- During the invitation, you will want to explain the process for the weekly gatherings.

#### **Explain the Process**

Discipleship is a process of helping humans follow Jesus everyday.

Discipleship Intensive can be used with any human...from one that has been saved for a century, to one who is not yet saved.

The principles and practices are essentially the same for everyone.

#### First section – Gospel of the Kingdom

Teaching Guideline is included and explains how to teach the Gospel Tract, "Now Enter God's Kingdom" in four lessons.

- By the way, if a "believer" cannot explain the Gospel, he is likely not saved. At the same time, most Christians, sad to say, have not been equipped to make a concise presentation of the Gospel. This material satisfies the need.
- Not only will they learn the Gospel, Discipleship Intensive will transform the way they live so much that they will want to teach it to others.

Through this section, I have personally seen many "Christians" really get saved – the Gospel is so powerful! Focus people on the Gospel of God's Kingdom. Once believers clearly understand the gospel, the Spirit of God will motivate them uniquely to overcome every obstacle to preach the Word.



#### **Second Section – Wheel of Life**

Once a person is saved, he or she will need to exercise their faith. Exercise means practicing the principles on a daily basis.

- This tool explains how they can develop balance in their spiritual lives.
- By the conclusion of this section, students commit to daily disciplines that cause them to follow Jesus everyday, including meditation for personal sanctification, communication with God in Bible reading and prayer (personal and intercessory), powerful fellowship, and persuasive evangelism.

#### Third Section – Uniquely You<sup>TM</sup>

This tool assists believers to identify God's work in their lives...to recognize how the Holy Spirit has gifted them, especially in discerning how those gifts combine with their personality type. With increased understanding of oneself, each student focuses where he or she functions most effectively.

- When this final section is completed, each student will be: 1) affirmed to recognize what he really enjoys, and
  - 2) encouraged to serve in a ministry that highlights his giftedness.

Imagine the power and excitement a person experiences when he is doing what he loves and what he does well!

#### Anticipate the Results

Step back for a moment and picture this scene. The church you attend is full of people who are smiling powerfully. Most, if not every person, are doing a service that they do well and that they love to do. Imagine the powerfully synergy of the Holy Spirit working amidst that church.

Friends, I tell you, this is not the outstanding church – this is the norm! This is what God intends for His people.

Jesus put it this way, "I came that they might have life, and life more abundant." (John 10:10) Abundance is the norm. And when a group of abundantly living saints gathers to stimulate each other to love and good deeds, there is spiritual power to transform cities. This is what Jesus expects from His church and every single one of His children. Discipleship Intensive.

Bible Reading – Pull your students with a challenge to read the entire gospel of Matthew this week (quickly). Encourage them to keep a journal for writing down observations, questions, and insights as they go through Discipleship Intensive. God will make incredible action with them. Stimulate them to pay close attention to what happens.



Here's the Story

#### **CREATOR CREATED**

In the first book of the Bible called Genesis, we discover these words: "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." The entire creation is God's Kingdom where He demonstrates His love and grace to all creatures.

God the Creator made a special Kingdom that consists of two dimensions: heavenly (spiritual) and earthly (physical). The Lord God then appointed rulers over each dimension of His Kingdom.

In the heavens, God appointed Lucifer as the "covering cherub," referring to his ruling role. On earth, Jesus appointed Adam and Eve to rule over the earth.

Everything was *very good* (Genesis 1:31).

#### SON SAVES

God's love moved Him to take action. God does not desire any person to suffer Satan's punishment (2 Pet. 3:9). So, God promised that He would provide a Savior so that all who believe Him would be redeemed.

The Lord Jesus Christ is the Savior. Jesus provided salvation for mankind by His perfect life and substitutionary death. The Bible says, "God made [Jesus] who knew no sin to become sin on our behalf that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" (2 Cor. 5:21).

You were born into Satan's kingdom. You can be born again into Jesus' Kingdom today. He will forgive you, fill you with power, and assure you of everlasting life (John 1:12, 3:3, 16). You do want to receive Jesus' payment for your sin, don't you?

#### Consider this ...

Everyone wants to be loved, don't they? In fact, you probably know someone who has done crazy acts because of love. True love causes people to take radical, sometimes sacrificial action, doesn't it? God's love for YOU caused Him to do something amazing.

As you now read God's story, you are going to learn what Jesus did because He loves YOU. It provides refreshing facts. And when you now receive the love God expresses to you, you are going to live life with magnificent power and glory. Everyone wants to hear God's love story.

#### CREATURES CORRUPTED

In the heavens, Lucifer set himself to take over God's Kingdom. He led a revolt in heaven to establish himself as king. He deceived one third of the angels to follow his scheme. His efforts smashed against God, and God stripped Lucifer of his original glory but allowed him limited power.

The devil then came to the earth with a plan to deceive Adam and Eve. He wanted them to follow his rebellious plan to "be like God, knowing good and evil." Adam and Eve joined the rebellion, ate the forbidden fruit, and became part of Satan's kingdom. Every person born of Adam is born into Satan's kingdom and destined for his destruction (Matt. 25:41). If God did not take action, every man would suffer hell.



#### THE KING WILL COME AGAIN

Jesus now reigns over His Kingdom from heaven. Soon He will suddenly appear, gather His children to Himself, and then pour out His wrath on those who rejected His offer of salvation.

You do want to receive His loving offer, don't you? You now believe the truth that redeems your soul from the devil's destruction. As you turn from darkness, pain, and confusion into the light and power of Jesus' Kingdom, take action now.

- A Acknowledge Jesus as your Lord and Savior and regard yourself as His servant.
- **B Beg for forgiveness** of your sins and He will cleanse you.
- C Celebrate your union with Christ in baptism.

He created the universe within His being. Illustration (ILL): If you could take a rocket that traveled several times the speed of light, you would get to the edge of the created universe. Q: When you crashed outside of the created universe, whom would you run into? A: <u>GOD</u> Transition (TRANS): So, what did God create? "God created <u>the heavens</u> and <u>the earth</u> " The <u>heavens</u> consists of two main <u>parts</u> The <u>physical</u> part – it is the <u>space</u> above the earth extending to the "waters above" (edge of the universe). The <u>spiritual</u> part – it is an actual physical realm where God set up His <u>throne</u> and <u>appointed</u> the angels He created. It is "spiritual" in that the five human physical senses cannot perceive it. God <u>created</u> and <u>appointed</u> Lucifer, the shining One, to rule over the heavens. The earth is the <u>globe</u> that we call <u>planet earth</u> . God <u>formed</u> and <u>filled</u> earth during the 6 Creation Days. On the <u>sixth</u> day, the Lord <u>created</u> and	Bible Reading: Gospel of Mark Study tract, "Whose Kingdom Are You In?" pp. 2-4, Crown and Creation of the Kingdom (located in back of DI Manual)
<b>appointed</b> Adam and Eve to <b>rule</b> over the earth.	
To conclude say, "By the way, we will get into many details of the creation later. Now recognize that the Creator God created a perfect universe over which He rules as King.	
Assign Homework: Invite them to read tract – "Whose Kingdom Are You In?" Explain: This tract develops your appreciation for God's Kingdom plan.

Genesis 1:1 – "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth"

I. "In the beginning, God..."

A. God's **<u>ETERNAL</u>** Existence – He has <u>**ALWAYS**</u> existed. God existed <u>**BEFORE**</u> Genesis 1:1.

B. Before the universe, God <u>ALREADY</u> existed. He is the great "<u>I AM</u>."

#### II. "God created ..."

A. God created the universe **<u>OUT OF NOTHING</u>** (EX NIHILO).

B. God created the universe <u>WITHIN</u> Him – there is no <u>PLACE</u> outside of God. He IS.

#### III. "...God created THE HEAVENS and THE EARTH."

A. The heavens consist of two main **PARTS**.

The **<u>PHYSICAL</u>** part – the <u>SPACE</u> above the earth extending to the "waters above."

The <u>SPIRITUAL</u> part - it is an actual physical realm where God set up His <u>THRONE</u> and <u>APPOINTED</u> the angels.

B. The earth is the <u>GLOBE</u> that we call <u>PLANET EARTH</u>. God <u>FORMED</u> and <u>FILLED</u> this earth during the Six Days of Creation.

On the <u>SIXTH</u> day, the Lord <u>CREATED</u> and <u>APPOINTED</u> Adam and Eve to <u>RULE</u> over the earth.

### **Application** Wheel of Life

What you have learned in the Wheel of Life is a system for maintaining balanced spiritual growth. By practicing these disciplines daily, you are going to kindle your heart's fire for the Lord. Commit to now practice disciplines all the days of your life.

### 1. Meditation – Focusing yourself to fellowship with God

- a. This is a personal time for you to center your mind on the truths of your salvation. Jesus saved you to live an abundant life. He loves you and wants you to experience all the blessings possible for you.
- b. Blessing happens continually when you learn, live, and teach the passages on "Christ as the center of your life" (2 Corinthians 5:17 and Galatians 2:20) and when you now take action to obey Him (Romans 12:1-2 and John 14:21).

### 2. Communication – This is the verbal conversation you enjoy with God

- a. Bible Reading Commit now to read God's Word daily to hear His words.
  - i. Read the New Testament and Old Testaments start to finish. Then enjoy a variety of reading plans and Bible versions. Recite regularly 2 Timothy 3:16-17 and 2 Peter 1:20-21.
  - ii. Know that you feel better when you read the Bible; and don't entertain "guilt" when you do not. Focus on the benefits that accompany daily Bible intake. Jesus is most interested in your direction "Turn and I will heal you" (2 Chron. 7:14).
- b. Prayer as Intercession Praying for others
  - i. Daily let your requests be made known to God, and enjoy the blessing of watching God work powerfully for others as you intercede for them.
  - ii. There is distinction between thinking and praying for someone. Invite God to do specific work in other people's hearts and circumstances.

### 3. Fellowship – Stimulating and encouraging other people to love and good deeds

- a. You now develop a determination to bless at least two believers each day with words of encouragement, counsel toward godly behavior, or exhortation to diligence. Recite Hebrews 10:24-25 to stir up motivation for fellowship.
- b. Other people need to know your love, so look for the opportunities Jesus presents as answers to your prayers.
- 4. Evangelism Intentionally seek to share the gospel of God's Kingdom everyday with at least one person, maybe three...and then keep track of them.
  - a. Contacts people you have attempted to share with
  - b. Gospel Presentations people you shared the entire gospel with.

### 5. Memorization – Stay in the process of hiding God's word in your heart daily.

- a. You have made a great start already, and it has blessed you, hasn't it?

The Uniquely Profile is self-explanatory; and the central ideas to emphasize are described below.

### Lesson 1 – Introduction and Spiritual Gifts Profile – pp. 1-7

Overview God's work in people, how He entrusts them with a package of gifts to be used for His glory. Explain how these internal motivations provide emotional ecstasy, so that a person does what they really enjoy and what they do well; thus, the person lives the abundant life Jesus intended. To get there, they may need to make changes to get what they really want and need!

Homework: Students complete Gifts Profile. Plot their giftedness and encourage them to recognize how wonderfully God made them with a fantastic combination of gifts.

### Lesson 2 – Personality Profile – pp. 8-19

Have students read and complete Personality Profile. Plot their personality traits on the two graphs: How Others See Me; How I See Myself. Help them evaluate their Personality and Gift Combinations.

Homework: Review their Spiritual Gifts and Personality Profile,

### Lesson 3 – Combining Personality with Spiritual Gifts – pp. 20-35

Assist them to identify their Behavioral Blend; consider a strategy for "controlling" strengths, aptitudes, and likes to maximize team-building and disciple-making. Also, help them recognize the patterns in their circles of influence and learn how to most effectively communicate with them.

Homework: Complete "My Action Plan" (p. 35) and be prepared to discuss this next meeting. Encourage students to create an autobiographical "oral essay" that describes their unique potentials for building the body of Christ.

### Lesson 4 – Evaluation and Taking Action

Have students share their Biographical Surveys with the team; learning about each other and how to communicate with one another. This is where you will begin to see the value of this process, so don't short-circuit this. Exhort them to open up and discuss!
