knocked out of bounds ahead of where red jammer is, white 10 is not a NOTT point, and red jammer would need to earn a pass on white 10 who is out of bounds but not enroute to the penalty box.

NOP points – (No Opportunity Points) Awarded at the end of a scoring trip, if they apply to that trip. A jammer does not need to have earned a pass on any blocker to earn any NOP points at the end of their scoring trip. If the jam ends while the jammer is in the EZ, the jammer is awarded all applicable NOPs. There is no trigger to earn NOPs, and NOPs do not trigger NOTTs.

Blocker who has left the EZ from the back and is behind the EZ when a jammer returns to the track from the Penalty Box in front of that Blocker

Blocker who is in front of the EZ when the jammer completes the scoring trip

Blocker who is in front of the EZ and the jam ends when the jammer is on a scoring trip and ahead of the rearmost Pack Blocker These are awarded for opponents the jammer did not have an opportunity to physically pass during their scoring trip. These points are earned regardless of other legal passes, but earning these points does not trigger NOTT points for the scoring trip. These are awarded at the end of the scoring trip when the jammer exits the EZ, or at the end of the jam if the jam ended during a scoring trip when the jammer was still in the EZ.

Once a point is legally earned, no action of the jammer or another skater takes that point away.
