

CLOSING

Glows and Grows: Allow students to volunteer to express what was done really well by themselves (this is reflective), and a "growing" comment would show what could use some improvement.
Kudos: Kudos is praise and honor received for an achievement. It is compliments or congratulations to students from the program staff AND from other participants. Please be prepared to give kudos and allow students to volunteer to give each other kudos.
TYPES OF KUDOS for Closing:
 Popcorn (open and close hands fast) Fireworks (high jazz hands) round of applause (clap in a circle)
Rewards: Allow students to put a sticker next to their name on the reward chart at the end of the day to account for late participants. Let them know that prizes will be given on every Monday. On Monday students get a raffle ticket for every day they attend in a week and a drawing is held for 10 prizes per week.
What's Next? Show the What's Next Poster. Some titles are obscure, let the students wonder! Students should take all artwork and projects home, no projects may be left at the school site.
