• 1 Corinthians 8:6

Yet for us there is but one Elohim, the Father, <u>from whom are all things and we exist for Him;</u> and one master, Yahshua Messiah, <u>by whom are all things, and we exist through Him.</u>

- John 4:24 Elohim is Spirit
- Jhn 14:10 Believe thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? The words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwells in me, he does the works.

Compare with John 14:26 & 15:26.

- Jhn 1:1 In the beginning be the Word, and the Word be with Elohim, and the Word be Elohim. Jhn 1:2 The same was in the beginning with Elohim.
- John 4:24 Elohim is Spirit
- Take a look at John 14:10: Don't you believe, I AM the Begotten Son in the Father, and the Father is in Me-Only Begotten Son? With this said, the Father that dwells in me does the works. Quite the play on words isn't it? If Father is in Son and Son is in Father, you have Holy Spirit.
- John 4:24 Elohim is Spirit
- 1John 1:2 said, the Word of Life is "It," "that" which was in the beginning with Elohim. So John 1:1 said: In the beginning is the Word, next thing he said, the Word of Life is "IT". This IT is in the beginning with Elohim, furthermore IT is Elohim. John deduced the Word as IT. Yes, John said: The Word of Life is a substance, in and with relationship of Holy Spirit. (We will come back to this thought shortly)
 - Mankind made it hard to wrap the brain around the thought: the Word is a substance, and having a relationship with itself in another form called Spirit. But to help us understand this relationship we have a scripture trail to guide us; of which we will mention shortly. Proverbs 8:21 unveils just enough about that substance bringing us to 1John 1:1-3.
- Does John indicate the thought: the Word, to the Word of Life takes on a new relationshipresponsibility apart from itself for itself? (I will be what I will be) Let's pause here for a thought; Word of life speaks of: Word producing Life, such as: The Word became flesh and the Word be with and is Elohim. The Word of Life propagates Life, because the Word is creator.
- Does this take us to Moses, IAM that IAM and IAM sent me? This Word, the self existing substance, that which produced Life as we relate to.
- Proverbs 8:21: That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures. Faith is the substance of things not seen.
- To help stay in John writings let us recall that Elohim is defined as: The Almighty One(s). Therefore Father and Son is Almighty One. Elohim is Spirit of Life or the Word of Life.
- This brings us around to a thought: The Word brings forth a relationship with itself, the Word of Life. **1Jn 1:1** That which was from the beginning (From the beginning, began in the second and third part of John 1:1; I think he is pulling out Proverbs 8:23), which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes (John 14:6-9), which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled (John 1:14), of the Word of life (Holy Spirit); **1:2** (For the life was manifested, and we have seen IT (Word), and bear witness, and shew unto you that (Word self existing) eternal

life, which was with the Father (Elohim-Spirit), and was manifested unto us (Son-Elohim, Php 2:5-8;)

- This reminds me of Proverbs 8:22: YAHWEH-Father possessed YAHSHUA-Son, in the beginning of His way, before his works of old (Holy Spirit-Elohim). These scriptures appear to bring a story: The Word, begets Holy Spirit; Holy Spirit-Father begets Holy Spirit Son. Let us make man in our likeness him, and let them have dominion. The story continues its repetition with Genesis 1:26-2:18: Elohim said to man-them, replenish the earth and subdue it. Subdue means in Hebrew, to set in order. First Adam was formed, then Eve taken out of Adam was formed. Adam and Eve propagate life together (man). Mat 21:21 brings us full circle too, in the beginning.
- The thought in Ecclesiastics 1:9-10 has its beginning with: In the Beginning.
- The seed is the Word of Holy Spirit, Luke 8:11.
- Genesis: and every seed shall bring after its kind.
- The Word is a substance it is singular with Holy Spirit. Is there life apart from Holy Spirit? The Word of Life is synonymic with The Word of Holy Spirit. It reminds me of Acts 2:38 And you shall receive the gift of Holy Spirit. I like how John first wrote: In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Holy Spirit expressing this further in 1John 1:1; the Word of Life; and IT, the substance, was manifest, that eternal life; as John saw it in Proverbs 8:22.
- I have said many times: the Word created Holy Spirit. But that may not be true according to the pattern the scriptures teach. As the Only begotten Son was not created, rather begotten; the Word a substance brought forth itself, into being, a Spirit.
- So then Holy Spirit, who Moses called Elohim is begotten from Word. Can we take from Paul's thought: **Php 2:6**? Who, being in the <u>form</u> of Holy Spirit, thought it not robbery to be equal with Holy Spirit? So then, The Word of Life (Spirit) thought it not robbery to be equal with Word (substance).

1Co 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:
