Coaches Report – Coach Spence Patrick

- Practice/Dual/Tournament Updates/Info:
 - This last weekend we had 5 kids place at the Bucks Bags Tournament.
 - Lucas Livingstone 4th place, Jaden Boyd 4th place, Hayden Harris 3rd place at the JV Tournament.
 - Erika Lyon 3rd place, Hailey Jo 1st place Champion in All-Girls Tournament. Varsity guys had 2 make it to the finals on the second day.
 - Saturday practice will be 8-10 am, Wed dual at Skyview weigh ins start at 5:00pm be there by 4:30pm

- Wish List Items:
 - Reno is a no, but working on other tournaments. In mind is varsity only in January at different venue than Tiger-Griz in Vernal, Utah. Would take a bus 7 hours to get there. Just Varsity so JV would still go to Tiger-Grizz; keep planning for Tiger-Grizz.
 - Also keeping Minico tournament.
 - Coach would like to rent a bus for future traveling tournaments but only if we have enough money in the budget to pay for whole season (officials, food coolers, tournament entry fees, hotels & meals for wrestlers & coaches first)

JV Tournament Chair Report – Ariel Patrick

- The planning is done! 31 schools last year, couple new schools coming in addition this year.
- Selling apparel on-site (navy blue tees, grey long sleeves & white sweatshirts for 30% kickback).
- Only doing awards for 1st-3rd place plus 2 outstanding wrestler trophies. Champions get award and shirt.
- Waffle Me Up will do waffles starting 10am Friday we will add coffee. Varsity will be at Rollie Lane, could use meal donations to help with WMU food donations, but we will check with Hector for needs.

- Hash browns for breakfast & baked potatoes for afternoon, still have plenty of chili & cheese to use up so we will add to menu
- Melissa Carico added that cookie scoops could be donated by Cinnaholic; sold for \$5 at their store and will look at doing something more next year. We can buy for \$1.50 so we can sell for \$3-5 each for profit. We will take sell for no less than \$3; Agreed we should do that.
- Spence is working on an app for JV tournament to make it easier to organize next year.
- We may need a tablet to use the square. Spence will check with the school to borrow for JV Tournament.
- Need to sell raffle tickets, maybe ping pong toss, we still need prizes; Almost 500 ping pong balls available to be sold at price of 1 for \$1 & 3 for \$5
- Ariel asked who to contact to have school social media accounts post tournament news; Contact is Student Body President Cam Massaad for MVHS MAVS Instagram
- Spotlight will not be repaired or replaced in time for JVT; missing wench & weight; school needs to order new one; Spence says cost is \$1000; Spence and Allison have spoken with Luke Wolf about process & funds and will report outcome at January Booster Meeting.
- Ariel will update the signup genius; needs to check the shifts & any other updates
- Income Report: School account is at \$9000 as of the 14th & money is still coming in.
 - Donation Letters: Letters are going really well. Sarah donated all the stamps and envelopes Next year they will be given out at the parent meeting. Probably around \$3000 just in that alone. Ariel sent 450 plus additional 25 this week.
 - Home Dual #1: First home dual was awesome money maker; last year \$300 this year over \$1300
 - Concessions & Spaghetti Meal: Successful! 42 plates of spaghetti sold. We get 100% of the concessions by doing it ourselves. Next home dual we will do baked potato bar to use up left over potatoes. Smaller school, less food needed.
 - Ping-Pong Sales: went well. Total sales unknown. May be able to report in January
 - Backpacks & Programs Sales: spaghetti/
 - Attendance: We get to keep all but the \$30 for gatekeeper fee; Tracking with the gate keeper is being recorded for future data

Secretary's Report – Jenny Baker

Treasurer's Report – Mandy Boyd

- Checking Account Balance: \$1881.92 as of last statement; Does not include new income from Square Sales and Pay Pal donations. Should really be about \$3200
- Savings Account Balance: \$170.04 as of last
- Proposed Budget for 2018-2019 Season: \$19,000-\$20,000

- Income Report:
 - Sponsorships: Unknown at this time. May be able to report in January
 - Sales (Concessions/Spaghetti/Backpacks/Programs/Sales): All done on
 - Mail-in Sponsorship donations received:
 - PayPal account balance: \$1544.97
 - Square: \$45.50 from first home dual (concessions)
 - Sold 2 backpacks \$90 at first dual
 - Melissa Carico asked us to clarify what the \$1300+ profit mentioned by Ariel Patrick was from and whether that includes actual profit from inventory. Can we get everything separated into categories? Is the \$300 listed in old records just from concessions or does that include the gate fees? Collaboration is needed between Ariel Patrick, Mandy Boyd & School Bookkeeper, Sarah Ingle to answer. Will follow up in January.

Operations Coordinator Report – Crystal Dickerson

- Tournament Transportation:
 - Worked really well for parents who did fill it out. Some did not fill it out or understand the process and reason behind tracking the transportation records.
 - We will need Coach Spence's clarification on future buses vs. parents driving farther in advance to allow for Coordinator to plan ahead for next duals.
 - Coach prefers all wrestlers to stay through the end of the tournament to see champion rounds.
 - Any parents wanting to leave early the 2nd day must be notified in advance to sign wrestler out with Coach prior to leaving.
- Food Coolers:
 - Need to separate orders for JV and Varsity
 - Still need typed & laminated instruction cards attached to inside lid of coolers.
 - Some of the issue is that JV parents are stepping up but not Varsity parents. Melissa Carico offered to recruit JV parents to commit & fill out the signup genius.
 - Coolers need to be stored at coordinator's house: Crystal agreed to do it
 - Crystals house 1889 East Rightwood Dr. Meridian, ID 83642
 - Will also get the meat from the Carico's & store in freezer
 - Contact phone number will be added to sign up genius (208) 912-3328
 - Need to keep the ice in Ziploc bags; also separate Ziploc bags for all cheese, granola bars, grapes, gogurts, etc,.
 - Takes about 1.5 hours for one parent to assemble. Label about a 2 hour job.
- OTHER:
 - Beckie Scherr asked about wrestlers competing outside of school during the school season. Crystal Dickerson offered to get clarification and report in January.

- Angela Hill works at Costco and says waters are on sale for \$2.99 now, 40 bottles 16.9 oz. Look into for JV Tournament.

 - Stephanie got Rudy's to donate a Gift Card
 - BSU is donating 2 gift baskets

 - Plan to raffle off one every hour or whatever.

- Soup Kettle will donate soup for coaches room but not sure how much
- Guru donuts & Blue Sky Bagels will donate for JV tournament
- Boise Fry Company donated 500 potatoes for JV Tournament
 - Might be calling people to help with pick up
- Tina Kierce said she is writing a grant to help pay for the \$4600 cost for State Tournament
- OTHER: Meals at tournament, we should plan for food available earlier in the am after weigh ins.

- Cheerleaders were great during the home dual. Nobody even heard them. Allison spoke to Coach Connie Condie on behalf of parents who complained about the noise last year and she was appalled that anyone would complain due to the cheer team's support of wrestling. Connie assured us they do what they can, but ultimately the school is only so big so the gym must be shared with multiple sports and all are equally important. It was agreed and the conversation ended amicably.
