DISCIPLESHIP AT HOME

Leading, helping our children walk in faith. For some families this may come easy in doing. Other families may be asking themselves, "how do I do this?!" or "how do I start?"

Here are some easy first steps:

- Morning Prayer
 Taking a morning pause to pray with your family to start the day.
- Drive Time
 Listen to Christian music, download a kid friendly Bible story app or talk about God's landscape.
- Dinner Discussions
 Focus your conversations around these questions; "What was a high or low for the day?", "Where did you see God today?"
- Bedtime Blessings
 Story time in the Bible. Pick a story to read, discuss the story and point out where God is in the story. Or this is a good time to ask, "Do you have anything on your mind?" End your day in prayer.
 (Children's Bible or Children's Bible Storybook would work best)

There's four weeks in a month, I would encourage starting with #1, Morning Prayer. Do this all week with your family. Then add another step. Do both all week with your family. By the end of the month you'll be doing all 4 steps with your family.

Loving God, loving your family... Deuteronomy 6:4-9 (NLT) "Listen, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. And you must love the lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength. And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are getting up. Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."
