Church is not a place to watch a performance. It's a headquarters for the battlefield. A place where Hell, though fighting, CANNOT win. Why? Because greater is He that is in us (which makes us the Church) than he that is in the world.

So gear up, soldier! Grab a weapon, go to the battle knowing God has won!






