The **Tara Beth Storey Memorial Scholarship** is given to honor the memory of Tara Beth Storey who died on January 18, 2012 after a valiant 7-week battle with leukemia. She was a member of Newcastle Christian Church, being baptized here on June 9, 2001 when she was 12. She was very loved, possessing a sweet spirit and cheerfulness that endeared her to all around her. Her latch hook of Jesus can be seen on the wall at the north end of the front hall, and there is a small memory garden for Tara at the northwest corner of the church as well. Tara had a form of autism that caused her some learning difficulties, but she overcame all obstacles to graduate from Newcastle High School in May of 2007, and proceeded to take courses at Oklahoma City Community College towards a library degree. She took one course per semester, and had accumulated 19 credit hours at the time of her death. Psalm 105:1 was hand-written in the front of her Bible, and we feel it's an appropriate scripture for her memorial scholarship.

Procedures and Requirements

STUDENT MUST BE AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF NEWCASTLE CHRISTIAN CHURCH, NOT JUST RELATED TO A MEMBER.

1. Student must maintain a **2.5 GPA**. *Your most-recent transcript **must be submitted** with the application **each semester**.* (If this application is for your first semester of college, please submit most recent high school transcript.) Does not have to be a certified copy, just something to show proof of the GPA.
2. Student must be a full-time undergraduate, enrolled at a Christian College or University.
3. Scholarship money is paid directly to the institution. Student will receive a letter shortly after the deadline about receipt of the scholarship, each time the scholarship is awarded, so that they know the money has been paid on their account.
4. The regular scholarship is **\$750 per semester**. An additional \$750 per semester is available for those who *qualify for the regular scholarship (qualifications 1 through 3 above)* and are enrolled in a *Christian **ministry major***., for a total of **\$1500 per semester**.
5. Applications must be submitted each semester by each student.
6. With the first awarding of the **Tara Beth Storey Memorial Scholarship**, recipient's name is added to the memorial plaque in the foyer, and they are recognized in front of the congregation. Subsequent awards will not be added to the plaque or recognized in church.
7. Please fill out the application on the next page and mail in to the church (or drop it off in the church office), *along with your transcript*. **Deadlines: August 1st for Fall Semester and January 1st for Spring Semester**.
