The ASCOT training series is spread out across five (5) weeks.

- **Week One: Tuesday, May 11 and Wednesday May 12 - 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM, daily.**
 - **Week Two: Monday, May 17 and Wednesday May 19 - 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM, daily.**
 - **Week Three and Four: no formal sessions: only scheduled Learning Coalition Check-Ins.**
 - **Week Five: Tuesday, June 8 and Wednesday June 9 - 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM, daily.**
- Training series participants will form Learning Coalitions with other Washington State community wellness promotion professionals to explore cross-cutting themes: Critical Self-awareness; Cultural Humility and Equity Literacy; Leading Change; and Sustainability as a strategy to strengthen their knowledge and skills for community engagement, organizing and mobilization.
 - Attendees will benefit from the experience of a team of seasoned prevention practitioners who through their cumulative experience, teaching, coaching and the unpacking of 6 Tool Boxes (1) Community Outreach and Engagement; 2) Coalition Building; 3) Group Facilitation; 4) Working with Volunteers; 5) Strategic Planning; and 6) Joint Problem Solving, facilitate a dynamic and very special learning opportunity.
