What's different about Forte music lesson?

In a Forte lesson, children use our unique **Whole Body Learning** approach which helps them learn quicker and remember more easily. What you'll notice in lessons is that children will...

- Sing and do actions to internalise learning before moving to the piano. This scaffolds the learning and provides a positive succession of little wins along the way.
- Students remember better, because the more neural pathways engaged in learning, the stronger the memory.
- Sing & play with music tracks and video clips which accelerates learning and develops a raft of skills, especially the ability to play in time and follow the music and it's fun!

Current neuroscience research shows that using embodied and multimodal learning strategies (Whole Body Learning) helps students learn more efficiently and remember more effectively.





Forte's Whole Body Learning teaching method is a combination of multi-sensory (including visual, auditory, and kinesthetic) and multi-modal where students move to different locations in the room, use backing tracks and other resources like percussion in the learning process.

Multi-sensory and Multi-modal learning has been proven to be the most brainfriendly way to learn.









EARLY CHILDHOOD MUSIC / INTRODUCTORY PIANO



Through our early childhood music courses your child will develop skills to help with both learning a musical instrument and preparing for school.

DISCRIMINATION:

Developing the ability to listen and hear the various nuances in sound can help with language development and social & emotional development.

SENSE OF BEAT:

What is Practice Buddy?

Practice Buddy is your in-home access to all the music we play in class to play along with at home. When playing with a backing track we are immersed in music and can simultaneously hear the entire sound of a piece and all of its parts.

Learning is accelerated and it's a lot of fun too!

Practising with Practice Buddy will help your child:

Learn Quicker - We learn small sections more quickly than we learn a whole piece and the Practice Buddy backing tracks provide a way for students to experience the whole piece whilst only being required to play small sections building confidence and competence.

Learn more skills - Playing in time is the foundation to learning any musical instrument. Playing with others in a band, orchestra or ensemble is crucial for long-term musical enjoyment. Critical listening skills are needed to do both of these and learning and practising along with Practice Buddy fast tracks these and other skills.

Remember more easily - When we practice with the music from class it transports us back to the memory of our lesson and what we learned. As the music plays our memories are triggered. In Practice Buddy, students can see an instructor's hands (visual) as they play the piece. Students can play the piece along with the instructor so it's like having the teacher at home. This is really great for parents if you feeling stressed because you don't know how to help them.
