Specifications for Christmas Cards

- Cards can be painted by any artist (amateur or professional) or can be done by a sign or graphics company. Cards should reflect a holiday's season greeting with a religious or non-religious theme.
- Cards may contain the name of your business, organization, or family in letters not to exceed 5" high. They should contain a holiday-spirited message to the community rather than a direct advertising one. If the card is done by a sign company or artist, that name may appear on the BACK of the card.
- Card Material: 1/2" plywood, MDO, or PVC board 4'x4' or 4'x6' (vertical or horizontal). The card may be presented in any shape or variation within these size limits, including a raised, cutout, or 3D design.
- Maximum OVERALL size of display, including the card, must not exceed 4'x6'.
- Two 4'x4' pressure treated posts 8' high are also to be supplied but are NOT TO BE ATTACHED to the card. This will be done upon installation by the Kiwanis members.
- The posts and backside of the card MUST be painted.
- Kiwanis members will be responsible for having holes dug and will mount cards to the 4'x4' posts. Dismantaling will be done by Kiwanis.
- Participants are responsible for delivery and pickup. Cards are to be delivered to Gilchrist Park between 9:00am-11:00am on Sunday, November 28, 2026 and picked up between 9:00am-11:00am on Saturday January 2, 2027.
- The Kiwanis Club is not responsible for the property of the participants. Participants are responsible for any repair or damage to their card once installed and should make periodic inspections.
- If a card does NOT meet these specifications, the Kiwanis Clubs reserve the right not to display the card.

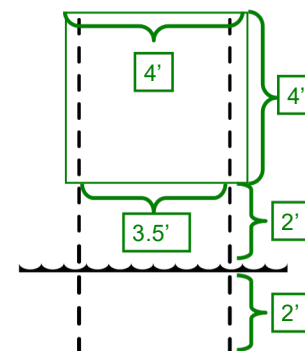
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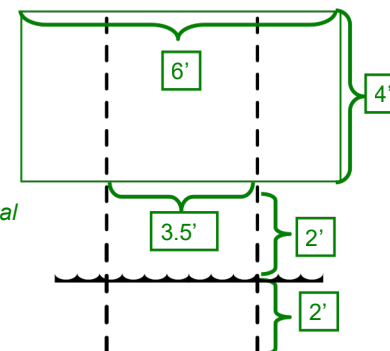
