Kristen is very passionate about Girls on the Run! Kristen got involved in GOTR in 2010 when she was a teacher and has been involved ever since. Girls on the Run’s mission is to inspire girls to be joyful, healthy and confident using a fun experience-based curriculum which creatively integrates running. 57% of teenage girls report feelings of persistent sadness and hopelessness with 1 in 3 seriously considering suicide. Charlotte county has served 356 students this year in 17 schools with almost 4000 girls since 2010. It costs each girl \$150 a season, but last year, GOTR awarded 240 girls full or partial scholarships given through donations. We were happy to donate \$250 to this worthy organization!
