## Gaylin Morris, Executive Director of Charlotte County Imagination Library

Charlotte County imagination Library was established in 2011 by Sherrie Moody of the Charlotte Players. This literacy program was Dolly Parton's idea. Her dad could not read, so she started this program as a tribute to her dad. Her dad told her that this was probably the most important thing she had ever done.

Gaylin Morris showed us how research proved that children who start reading at an early age do much better at school. Many lower income children do not have access to books, therefore do not do as well in school - causing many to drop out by the time they reach high school.

Charlotte County has over 9000 recipients of these books each month. Twelve books costs \$50 a month so the Imagination library is always looking for donations. Our Club was happy to donate \$1200 to the Charlotte County Imagination Library which will purchase 24 books each month for the whole year!
