**John Davidson & Liz Green from Crossroads Hope Academy**

Always great to see John Davidson and Liz Green from Crossroads Hope Academy! John talked to us about how everyday life is going at the group home. He reminded us that Crossroads is no longer a juvenile justice home - that ended in around 2012. The group home uses collaborative problem solving to deal with the behavior problems.

After acquiring the second home in 2022, Crossroads can accommodate 48 boys, but they like to stay around 38. They currently have 17 in one home and 18 in another. John and his team are very selective on who they bring to the group home because they want to make sure that the

boys are a good fit and that the home can meet their needs. They just recently celebrated "Chico" - one of their "graduates" for graduating from the fire school program and is now moving on to the EMT program! The Nix Christmas party this year was at the Life Church and only included a total of 80 people which made the party more relaxed and was their best Christmas party yet. The boys received gifts donated by the Sacred Heart Catholic Church. The Davidson Christmas party will be in Babcock Ranch with the Community Church supporting them.

Our club was able to present a \$300 check to them.
