This not-for-profit venue is staffed by volunteers and is managed by the Leongatha Art and Craft Society Inc (LACS), which was established in 1973 to support local artists. Membership fees and sales commissions cover our operating expenses. The Gallery and Gift Shop sells a large variety of unique art and craft items, which are all created by talented local artists and artisans from South Gippsland and surrounding areas.

RULES OF THE SOCIETY

1. Only LACS members and guest artists can sell their art/craftwork in the Gallery shop, unless decided otherwise by the LACS committee. As a LACS member you will be given your membership/stock record number, after your membership is approved.

2. All items must be made, crafted, or published by a member, and must exhibit a high level of artistic skill. Items with limited artistic input won't be accepted, e.g. purchased items with minimal creative content, or basic machine-sewn items with little decoration. Items that breach copyright laws won't be accepted. The Display Committee has the authority to accept or reject stock, and to limit the number of items that members have on display for sale at any one time.

3. Items for sale must be entered into the Stock Book according to instructions provided. All items must be identified with tags (provided by LACS) showing the member's number, item number, price, and a brief description. Tags can be attached with string or tape. Stock must then be put in the storeroom on the black shelves. The display committee will assess all items and, if approved, will display stock in the Gallery and put replenishment stock on the storeroom shelves. Members are not allowed to rearrange display stock.

4. Sales commission of 30% will be deducted from all non-volunteer members' sales. Volunteer members, who do Gallery duty once a month or who assist with an admin role, will have 15% deducted from sales.

5. The Gallery takes all reasonable care of members' work, but members are responsible for ensuring their work is in good condition and correctly priced while it remains in the Gallery. Please note that the LACS Contents Insurance does not include cover for members' or friends' property and/or any stock. Members are responsible for their own insurance.

6. All Members must abide by our Code of Conduct policy, which is available to read in our Hand Book. Any disputes must be referred to LACS Committee.

Commission on sales will be reduced from 30% to 15% if you do monthly Gallery duty. You have the option of choosing a regular day that suits you, or putting your name down ad hoc, alongside another experienced volunteer.

Note - New volunteers will be partnered with an experienced volunteer for training, until they feel confident doing solo shifts if needed. You also have the option of sharing Gallery duty with another member on a regular basis, if you don't wish to work alone.
