B-22:

Apparatus is currently in service.

B-21 (New Heavy):

This unit is currently in service and fully operational. No issues noted.

The unit is being checked weekly and is our Reserve Medic unit.

Rescue 22:

Apparatus is being checked daily and is in service. This unit is still being utilized as a temporary Command.
