Emergency Response:

- For the month of November, there were a total of **34** fire calls.

Emergency Vehicles:

B-22:

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational. It was involved in a wreck, in which a commercial vehicle rear-end the rear drivers side. They took responsibility and will be paying to fix it. I've started working with the adjuster to start the process.

Medic 22: Currently out of service. During a patient transport the engine threw a rod. Luckily the unit still was under the power train warranty and currently is getting a new engine at Price. There will be cost associated to us for the repairs.

Tender 22: Currently this unit is in service with no issues.

Engine 22: It is currently at Siddons having a PM done and fixing a few things needed operationally.

Medic 21: This unit is currently in service at Station 2. No new issues reported with this unit.

Brush 21: It is currently operational and at Station 2. Future repairs will be needed to the plumbing and the pump.

Rescue 22: Currently in service as command. The water pump failed and repairs were made to keep operational.

Engine 21: Is currently at Siddons having repairs made to the tank, there is heavy interest in the purchase of this unit by a Fire Dept. in which me and commissioner Burleson showed the unit to them.

Public Relations:
