**Rescue 22:** Currently in service as command. The water pump failed and repairs were made to keep operational.

Engine 21: Is currently at Siddons having repairs made to the tank, there is heavy interest in the purchase of this unit by a Fire Dept. in which me and commissioner Burleson showed the unit to them.
