Emergency Vehicles:

B-22:

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational..

B-21 (New Heavy):

Apparatus is being checked daily and in service, eventually we're going to have to re-pipe the tank to pump feeder line due to leaks. Currently it is operational.

(Present time: It's been moved to Station 1 and its being utilized as a reserve Brush truck)

E-22-B:

This unit is currently being serviced at Siddons for repairs then will be placed on the market for sale.

E-22:

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational.. Rear 4 tires were replaced. Radiator leak was fixed.

T-21:

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational.

M-21 (New Medic Unit):

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational.

M-23:

The unit is being checked weekly and is our Reserve Medic unit at Station 1.

Rescue 22:

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational. This unit is still being utilized as a temporary Command. Mobile Radio was installed.

We are fully staffed with Paramedics on every shift.
