Monthly Command Report For January Emergency Response:

- For the month of January there were a total of **14 fire** calls.
- For the month of January, **Fire** units first responded to Asst. D2 **EMS** on <u>44</u> calls.
- For the month of January, there were a total of <u>51</u> 911 EMS calls, <u>31</u> transports, <u>11 refusals</u>, <u>9</u> no Pt/DOA/Canceled calls.

Average response time, 7 Minutes, and 54 seconds (Per RMS Average)

Emergency Vehicles:

B-22:

Apparatus is currently in service at Station 2, pump push start is O.O.S. Pull string start still works.

B-21 (New Heavy):

Apparatus is being checked daily and in service at Station 2, eventually we're going to have to re-pipe the tank lines. The tank to pump feeder line was replaced. Currently it is operational and at Station 2.

E-22-B:

This unit is currently being serviced at Siddons for repairs then will be placed on the market for sale.

E-22:

This Apparatus is currently in service at Station 2. A piston valve that had a leak has been replaced with a steamer cap. We're looking into ordering 3 piston valves.

T-21:

This unit is currently in service and fully operational. No issues noted.

(Present time: It is at Station 2 and kept parked in the bay to protect it, with it being new.)

M-21 (New Medic Unit):

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 with no reported issues.

M-22:

The unit is O.O.S. service at Station 1, repairs have been made by Siddons and ready to be sold. All medical equipment has been removed from this unit.

M-23:

The unit is being checked weekly and is our backup Medic unit. Currently it's located at Station 1. (Present time: I believe it will need new front tires soon.)

Rescue 22:

Apparatus is being checked daily and is in service. This unit is still being utilized as a temporary Command.

MISC:

We have an abundance of expired medical supplies that's currently being stored upstairs at Station 1.

Personnel:

New hires have started on boarding. I happy to announce the two new employee's are firefighter/Paramedics, full-time Fire/Paramedics puts us at 6.

Stations:

Currently Station 1 is not staffed. I've taken appropriate measures to maximize savings by keeping everything shut off. Metal clutter from Station 1 and Station 2 has been removed, soon we will haul all trash around both stations to the county dump. During the freeze a multiple pipe busted at Station 1. Recently repairs were made.

Grants/Donations:

I'm working with a third party company on the ASSP to recoup funds for non-paid billing from EMS runs. I will elaborate more in person.
