



Monthly Command Report For October Emergency Response:

- For the month of October, there were a total of **23 Fire** calls.
- For the month of October, **Fire** units first responded to Asst. D2 **EMS** on **50** calls.
- For the month of October, there were a total of <u>54</u> EMS calls, which <u>42</u> were transported. Mutual aid agencies responded to an est. of 3 calls for service.

Average response time for October, 8 Minutes, and 10 seconds (Per ITE Average est.)

Emergency Vehicles:

<u>B-22</u>: This unit is currently in service with no issues.

Medic 22: This unit is currently in service with no operational issues, cosmetic body repairs will made this month

Tender 22: This unit is currently in service with no issues.

Engine 22: This unit is currently in service.

<u>Medic 21:</u> This unit is currently out of service and at an automotive shop having repairs completed.

Brush 21: This unit is currently out of service and getting repairs done on the plumbing and pump issues. The new pump was ordered and delivered for this unit.

<u>Rescue 22:</u> Currently in service and being utilized by Division Chief Aaron Bonner while working Monday-Friday 8-5.

21 Chief Command: Currently in service, this unit is the Chiefs primary response vehicle. I will still be in service over nights for the majority of the week and respond to major incidents over night.
