### **LEGAL FIRES DURING A BURN BAN**

- (1) BBQ fires are permitted as long as they are contained to a BBQ pit or fire ring. Be sure to discard your coals and ashes safely by dousing them in water once finished cooking. Do NOT discard coals or ashes in a trashcan. Dispose of them in a non-flammable container.**
- (2) Trash: You are allowed to burn household trash as long as it is burned in a barrel with a screen top. Be sure to stay out with the fire and have a water source nearby.**
- (3) Recreational Fires (i.e. campfires, fire pits) are allowed as long as they are kept in a "fire ring" to prevent spread of fire. These fires cannot be unattended, and you must keep a water source nearby. This does NOT include brush piles.**
- (4) Agricultural burning is allowed in accordance with Local Government Code 352.081(f). AG burns must be supervised by a Certified and Insured Prescribed Burn Manager. AG permits will need to be obtained from the Emergency Management office by the burn manager at least 24 hours prior to burning.**
