B-22:

B-21 (New Heavy):

This unit is currently out of service, hose from the tank to pump feeder line busted on a grass fire call. Currently parts our being looked for to fix. It will be an in house fix.

<u> E-22-B:</u>

This unit is currently being serviced at Siddons for repairs then will be placed on the market for sale.

E-22:

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational.

T-21:

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational.

M-21 (New Medic Unit):

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational. Issues with exhaust system/DEF system have been noted and has been worked on by Price Dodge.

M-23:

The unit is being checked weekly and is our Reserve Medic unit at Station 1.

Rescue 22:

This unit is currently in service at Station 2 and fully operational. This unit is still being utilized as a temporary Command. Mobile Radio was installed.
