Emergency Vehicles:

<u>B-22:</u> This unit is currently in service with no issues.

<u>Medic 22:</u> This unit is currently in service with no operational issues, however there was body damage to the unit while responding to a call which repairs will made.

<u>Tender 22:</u> This unit is currently in service with no issues.

Engine 22: This unit is currently in service. Repairs were made to the rear drivers side brake drum due to wear and tear.

<u>Medic 21:</u> This unit is currently out of service and at an automotive shop having repairs completed.

Brush 21: This unit is currently out of service and getting repairs done on the plumbing and pump issues. The new pump was ordered and delivered for this unit.

<u>Rescue 22:</u> Currently in service as command. The new command vehicle has been delivered and taken to Farrwest for out fitting.
